Question: Are there any women writers in the history of the Church?

Answer: The resounding answer is YES! Stretching back to the 3rd and 4th century there were many "Desert Mothers" so called. Most of these were women who lived in the North African & Mid-East deserts (Syria, Iraq, Kuwait, etc.). They were contemplatives, some of them hermits. Many of their writings still exist today and are a solid foundation of spirituality in Eastern Rite Christianity. Within the Roman Church (Western Rite) St. Catherine of Siena, St. Teresa of Avila, St. Hildegard, and St. Therese of Lisieux are "Doctors" of the Church. St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein, a Jewish convert, Carmelite religious, scholar, author, martyred at Auschwitz) has left a rich body of Catholic literature for 20-21 century readers. Many women today have graduate degrees in theology and scripture, some of them published authors.
