MONTHLY ROSARY: **Monday, March 27 at 6:30 PM** in Sts. Peter & Paul Chapel

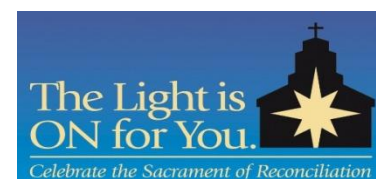
