**Holy Family Parish has "Direct Connect" with God. Cell phones & text messaging are not needed at this time. Please shut them off in church. Thank you.**

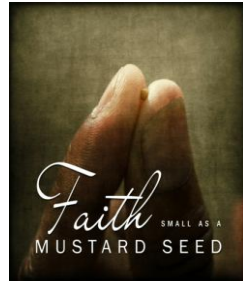
**LOCAL UPCOMING SUMMER FESTIVAL DATES:**
