



PLEASE NOTE: It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil & state regulations. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children & Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional & spiritual well-being.
