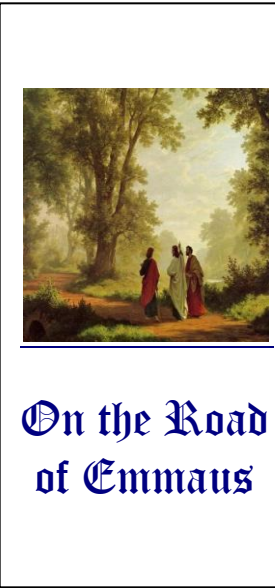

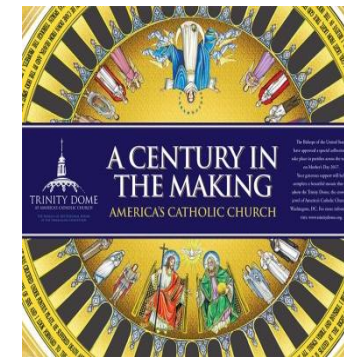
CHOIR PRACTICE: will be held on **Wednesday, May 3** at 7:00 PM
