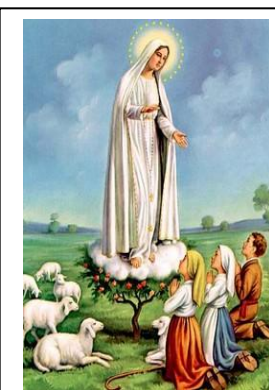

Pray the Rosary – The Brown Scapular of Mount Carmel – Five First Saturday's

This weekend marks the 100th anniversary of the famed apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to three children at Fatima, Portugal, beginning May 13, 1917 and ending October 13, 1917. The children were **St. Lucy dos Santos**, and her cousins, **St. Francisco Marto** and **St. Jacinta Marto**. They were **Canonized** this weekend, **May 13, 2017** by Pope Francis.



In all Her appearances, Mary emphasized the necessity of the Rosary, the Brown Scapular, and First Saturdays. 100 years later, it would be good for all Catholics to renew their devotion to Mary. We can always rely on Her to bring us into closer union with Jesus, Her Son.
