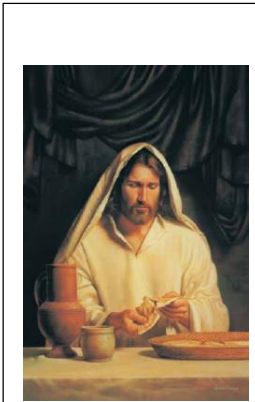

ADULT RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: starting this semester a bible study course titled **"ACTS: the Spread of the Gospel"** will be offered.
