

GREAT LAKES CLINICAL TRIALS

Ashland Ave. Clinical trials are carefully supervised research studies, whereby new investigational treatments and medications are evaluated for safety and effectiveness by a medical team. Clinical research studies offer volunteers the benefits of free physical exams, study related medical testing and study medication. Many studies offer compensation for your time and travel, and transportation is provided if needed. If you would be interested in participating in one of their clinical trials, you may contact them at 773-275-3500. Ask for Maura Stefanik. When you call, mention that you were referred by St. Gregory the Great Church. If you are accepted in a clinical trial, they will send us a check for \$100. They are currently offering clinical trials in the areas of Alzheimer's Disease, chronic regional pain syndrome, fibromyalgia, mild cognitive impairment, depression, post-traumatic stress disorder and many more.
