INFANT BAPTISM: To schedule a Baptism, please contact the Parish Office. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Baptismal session. Sessions will be held at Risen Lord Parish on the third Sunday of each month. Registration for the Sacrament of Baptism and the celebration of the Sacrament will still be at the individual parishes on the last Sunday of the month.

MARRIAGE: Dates for Marriages are scheduled only through the Priest and only after an initial meeting with the couple. Church law requires a minimum of six months notice before a wedding can be celebrated. In light of the many arrangements for a wedding, the couple should contact the Priest as soon as possible after the engagement is announced.

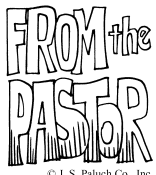
INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC: Those wishing to share in the sacramental life of the Church are invited to contact the Parish Office. This specifically applies to those wishing to be baptized, who have not previously shared in the Eucharist, who have not sought to share the sacrament of Confirmation, or those raised in another faith but now choosing to share our Catholic faith.

HOSPITALIZED OR HOMEBOUND: If a parishioner is in the hospital or sick at home, please call the Social Ministry Office to arrange for a pastoral visit. Each hospital has a priest, either as a chaplain or assigned from a neighboring parish, for emergencies.

SPONSOR LETTERS: Only active and registered members will be issued a Sponsor Letter. The Sponsor should contact the Parish Office at least one week prior to the date needed.

THE FOURTH OF JULY HOLIDAY is upon us and we celebrate our freedom as a nation with pride. Our forefathers worked tirelessly to preserve our independence and today, men and women continue to protect our freedom. May we all have a safe holiday!

AT VARIOUS TIMES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR, requests are made for sponsor papers so that an individual can stand as a sponsor for baptism or confirmation. So often, when these requests are made, what people end up asking for is not what is really needed. So, this would beg the question, "What is really required when asked to be a sponsor?" What is required is this: a sponsor eligibility certificate. This certificate is signed by both the pastor/parochial vicar and the sponsor themselves. This certificate states that the sponsor is baptized, made their first holy communion, and is confirmed AND that they are practicing their faith in conformity with the laws of the Catholic Church (which includes, among other things, attending Mass weekly). If the prospective sponsor is married, their marriage must be one that took place before a Catholic priest and two witnesses or with the permission of the Catholic Church, before a minister of another faith. Simply presenting a copy of one's own baptismal certificate would not meet the requirement.
