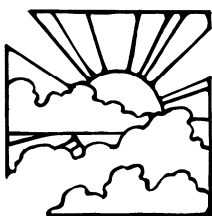

**RECONCILIATION:** Saturday afternoon 3:00 - 3:30 p.m. before the 4:00 p.m. Mass or by appointment.

**INFANT BAPTISM:** To schedule a Baptism, please contact the Parish Office. Parents are expected to attend a Pre-Baptismal session. Sessions will be held at Risen Lord Parish on the third Sunday of each month. Registration for the Sacrament of Baptism and the celebration of the Sacrament will still be at the individual parishes on the last Sunday of the month.

**MARRIAGE:** Dates for Marriages are scheduled only through the Priest and only after an initial meeting with the couple. Church law requires a minimum of six months notice before a wedding can be celebrated. In light of the many arrangements for a wedding, the couple should contact the Priest as soon as possible after the engagement is announced.

**INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC:** Those wishing to share in the sacramental life of the Church are invited to contact the Parish Office. This specifically applies to those wishing to be baptized, who have not previously shared in the Eucharist, who have not sought to share the sacrament of Confirmation, or those raised in another faith but now choosing to share our Catholic faith.

**HOSPITALIZED OR HOMEBOUND:** If a parishioner is in the hospital or sick at home, please call the Social Ministry Office to arrange for a pastoral visit. Each hospital has a priest, either as a chaplain or assigned from a neighboring parish, for emergencies.

**SPONSOR LETTERS:** Only active and registered members will be issued a Sponsor Letter. The Sponsor should contact the Parish Office at least one week prior to the date needed.

**BULLETIN:** Submissions can be made to bulletinINCandRL@comcast.net. Deadline is 12:00 p.m. on Friday (nine days before the Sunday of the intended publication). Submissions are subject to approval and space limitations.

**Why Eucharistic Adoration**

We can learn about adoration from the three wise men. After Jesus was born, the wise men came to adore Jesus and gave him praise. We do the same in Eucharistic adoration. Eucharist means *Thanksgiving*. *We praise and thank Jesus for his sacrifice on the cross so we could have salvation.* Jesus himself gives us an example and an invitation. The night before he died, he went to the garden of Gethsemane to pray to his Father. At that time, he asked the disciples to stay awake and pray with him for one hour. When we gather for Eucharistic adoration, we are praying with Jesus just like the first disciples. (May we not fall asleep). God blesses us abundantly for the time we spend in adoration. He gives us strength and grace for our journey here on earth and for heaven. The loving relation that we develop with Jesus during Eucharistic adoration transfers to our celebration of the Mass.

**On Sunday, November 20th, the Feast of Christ the King, (Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe) we will have Eucharistic adoration immediately following the 9:00 AM Mass at Incarnation of the Lord until it regularly ends at 4:00 PM and immediately following the 11:00 AM Mass at Risen Lord Parish for one hour. Please consider devoting some extra time with the Lord. It's the best time you will spend on Earth.**

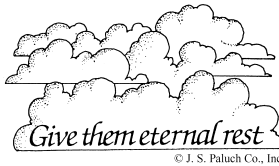

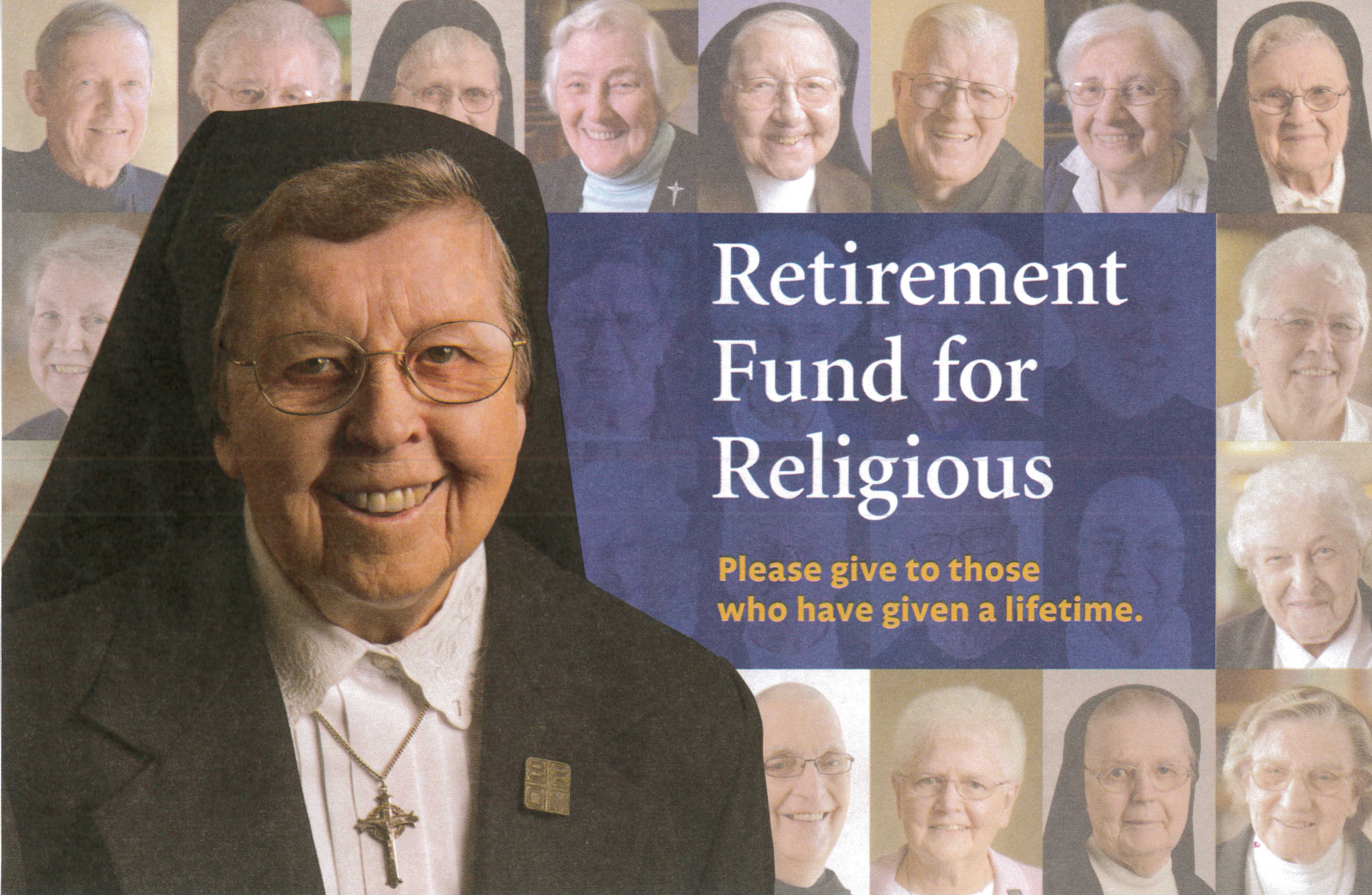
