



Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. We are reminded in today's readings about God's mercy. Even if we do not always do as Jesus wants, He does not abandon us. Jesus appeared to the Apostles, but Thomas was not there. Thomas had trouble believing that Jesus had risen from the dead. He said to the other Apostles, "Unless I see the wounds myself and put my hand in His side, I will not believe." Jesus comes back again and He is not angry at Thomas, but shows mercy to Thomas. He says, "Come put your hands in my side". Thomas falls on his knees saying, "My Lord and my God". Jesus replies, "Blessed are they who have not seen and still believe." He's speaking of us. This was a blessing for us from Jesus. We were in His thoughts over two thousand years ago, all of us because we believe. Imagine that!


In the Jubilee Year 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina Kowalska and proclaimed to the world that the second Sunday of Easter would be Divine Mercy Sunday. St Faustina had many visions including purgatory and hell. In a vision she was directed to make a painting of our Lord. In another vision she saw the anger God had towards the world. She began praying the prayers of the Divine Mercy and saw that God's anger was held back. If anyone prays this chaplet in trust of God will attain the grace from the most infinite mercy. The Divine Mercy Chaplet should be prayed for nine days beginning on Good Friday. There are many promises made to us through the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Every Sunday at Incarnation there is Eucharistic Adoration and the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy is prayed at 3:00P.M. St Faustina's life story is worth researching, as a reminder of how merciful our God is.

**Breaking Open the Word: John 20:19-31**

**Listen to the Word:** As you hear this reading, what words or phrases strike you? What in this reading touches your heart? What lingers in your memory?

**Look into Your Life:**

**Children:** Jesus appeared to the disciples even though they were afraid and locked in the closed room. How can you show Jesus to another person this week by how you act?

**Youth:** Thomas didn't believe because he hadn't seen Jesus with his own eyes. How hard is it for you to believe in God without being able to see God? How do you see God in the words and actions of others?

**Adults:** Jesus said: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe." Give one example of how you will show your belief in Jesus this week - how you are being sent forth.

**ON MISSION FOR CHURCH ALIVE**

It is a word that is shot through the Gospels and Acts – disciples. Jesus is walking with his disciples, talking with his disciples. And he is always teaching his disciples. They are his closest followers after the Apostles. There is the Commission of the 70 when Jesus sends them out in pairs "like lambs among the wolves" to prepare the way for him (Luke 10: 1-24). Just as in Scripture, we are called to this discipleship. We need to seek out what this means to us today in how we live out our faith.




