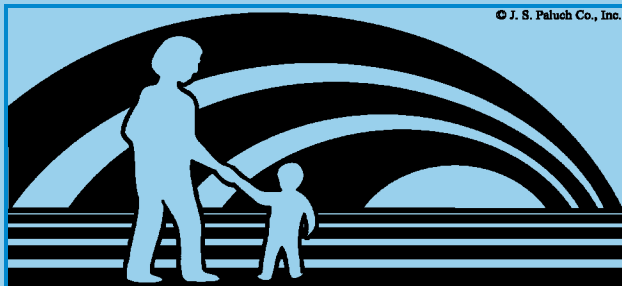
### SACRAMENTS :
