Dear Parishioners:



Alleluia! He is Risen! Today we celebrate the most solemn feast of the year, the Resurrection of our Blessed Lord, or as we call it, Easter. The origin of the word Easter comes from the same word for “East”, the direction from which the sun rises each morning – fitting for now the Son has risen from the dead. If we spent 40 days in solemn preparation with acts of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, then these Lenten penitential practices give way now to an even longer 50-day season of rejoicing. In these days, we will also celebrate the glorious Ascension of Our Blessed Lord, thus completing the Paschal Mystery, and also the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

But the first *eight days*, the “*Octave*” of Easter have a special solemnity. We celebrate Mass each day this week as if it were Sunday with the Gloria and Alleluia sung or recited. The dismissal at the end of Mass has a double-alleluia, as if to make up for the time in which these glorious words of praise to God were suppressed during Lent. And the Octave of Easter culminates next Sunday with the Feast of Divine Mercy.

You may recall that in 2000, upon the canonization of St. Faustina, St. John Paul II declared that throughout the Church, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter would now be known as the Feast of Divine Mercy. In one of many revelations to St. Faustina, our Blessed Lord Jesus said: *“My daughter, tell the whole world about My Inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. ... The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy”* (Diary 699).

What a revelation – what an invitation. At St. Theodore, we will celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy in a special way. At 2 p.m., we will offer candles and Divine Mercy images for a donation to be blessed during the service. At 2:30 p.m. the program will begin, which will include Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, blessing and veneration of the Divine Mercy image, singing the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and solemn Benediction. We will also learn about the plenary indulgence attached to this solemn feast.

A word about indulgences: We know that sacramental Confession offers forgiveness of the eternal punishment due to sin. But the *temporal punishment* due often remains. That is why we complete our penance given to us in Confession. Also, we engage in the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, and we perform acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving in reparation for our own sins and those of the whole world. Indeed, if we die in a state of grace, we have the blessed hope of eternal life, either immediately, or after a period of purgation (Purgatory), depending on whether the remission of the *temporal punishment* due to sin has been fully satisfied. An indulgence, however, provides forgiveness of all or part of the *temporal punishment* due to sin already forgiven in Confession. So an indulgence is a great gift of the Church relying on the infinite and unfathomable mercy of Jesus. How could we let such an opportunity pass us by? So please join us next Sunday for Divine Mercy services here at church, and bring your family and friends.

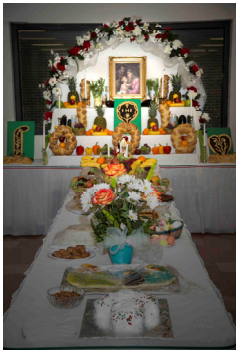

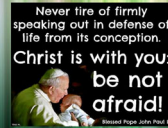
