Scriptural Teaching

An Inquisitive Walk through the Scripture, 75

We recommend keeping these reflections in a three-ring binder for the sake of pondering, challenging, questioning what is offered. Please consider that this is a series and some things may not be as clear if all individual reflections are not read.

Last week we pondered the Two Great Commandments as being fulfilled by Jesus in a way that no one else could fulfill. This is very important and essential to comprehend Jesus as the Promised Messiah since it is the purpose of the Messiah to bring glory to God by reconciling humanity to God and uniting all things in Himself. (cf. Ephs. 1) It was not possible last week due to space to quote a prayer of Jesus for His disciples (us) that beautifully illustrates this.

“I do not pray for these only, but also for those who believe in Me through their word, that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe You have sent Me. The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and You in Me, so that the world may know that You have sent Me and have loved them even as You have loved Me. Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, may be with me where I am, to behold My glory which You have given Me in Your love for Me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father, the world has not known You, but I have known You; and these know that You have sent Me. I made known to them Your name, and I will make it known, that the love with which You have loved Me may be in them, and I in them.” (Jn. 17:20-26)

We humans were destined from before the foundation of the world to share in the life of God. The sin of our first parents made this pretty difficult - and indeed impossible for mere humanity - and so God began to reveal His plan for our salvation. He promised Adam and Eve that one of their descendents would come to “bruise the head” of the serpent. He began a new generation with Noah and then chose a specific man, Abram, to whom He made the Promise of Messiah. This was communicated to Abraham’s son Isaac and his son Jacob. The Law was gifted to Israel through Moses at the Sinai Covenant. Of Jacob/Israel’s twelve sons, Judah would be chosen as the tribe of the Messiah-King. From Judah came David. Joseph and Mary are descendents of David through two different lines, each of which is necessary for the credentials of the one Messiah. Prophets and Wisdom literature would provide even more credentials for recognizing the Messiah – all for the sake of sharing in the glory of God and being one with God. Next week we will resume looking at some particulars.

Amen.

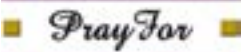
