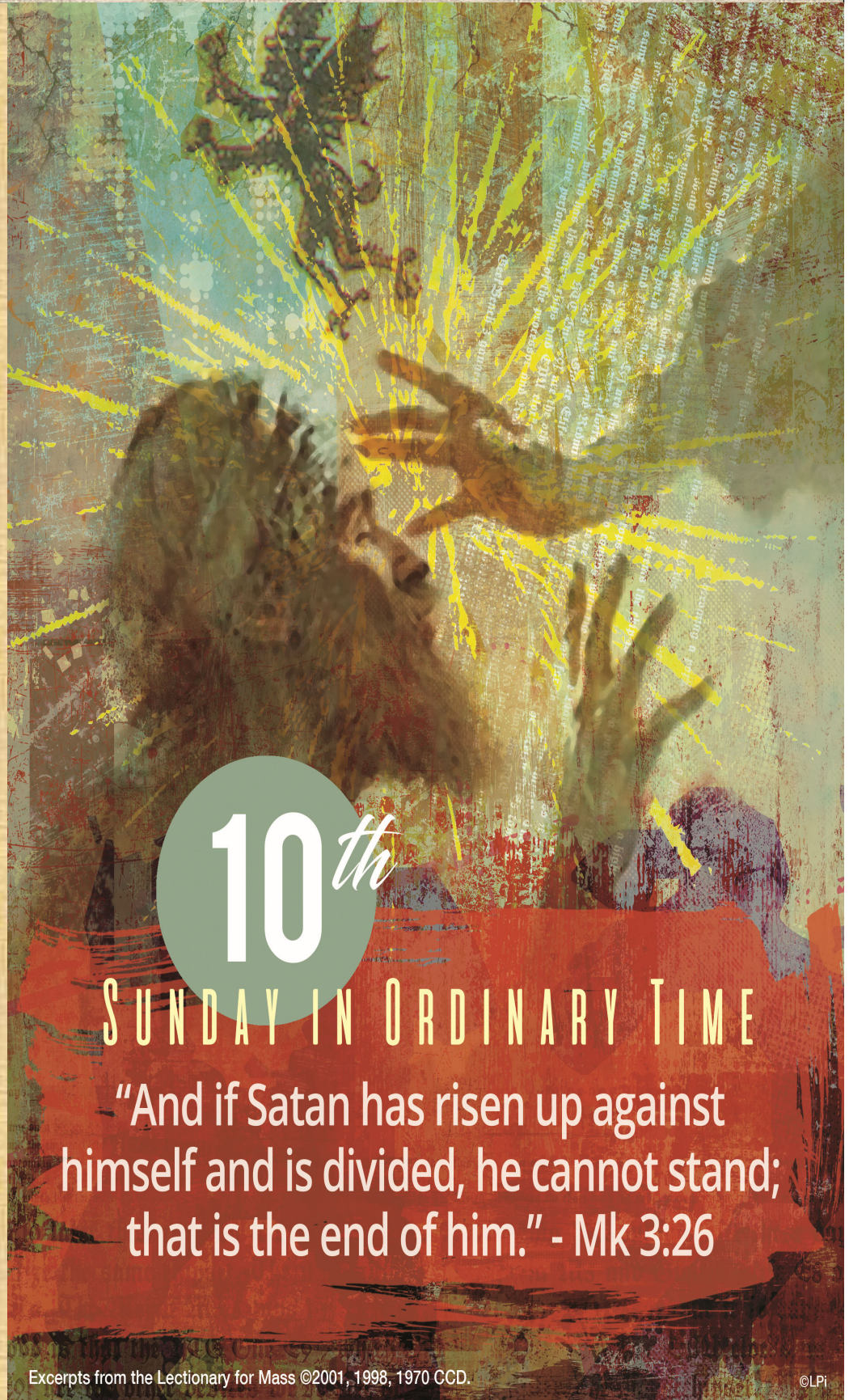

**Three Reasons Why Your Children
Should Be Altar Servers**

You're Fostering a Future Vocation:

According to a recent study, 75% of the 2012 class of Seminarians were altar servers. It's no coincidence that when your children fall in love with the Mass, they fall deeper in love with God. Whether your children choose a religious vocation or one of married life, the effect of experiencing the Mass in a personal way can only help to further their faith life in the very best of ways.

Respect and Understanding of the Mass:

One family shared, "In the early days, we struggled just to keep our son quiet in the pew. As he grew into a school-aged child, he was present but still very unaware and uninterested in the Mass. It wasn't until he began serving that we saw almost an immediate shift in his approach to the Mass."

An Opportunity for Leadership:

When children first begin serving, they start by shadowing other altar servers. You can see how anxious they are! But as time goes on you will see these young ladies and men mentoring younger servers. You can see them taking pride in making sure the Mass goes smoothly. You will see them learning to be a leader by example.

Pope Francis spoke to over 9000 altar servers in Vatican City a few years ago. Serving at the altar, the pope told the young people, is a privileged way to draw closer to Jesus, which in turn "enables you to open yourselves to others, to journey together, to set demanding goals and to find the strength to achieve them."

In addition to preaching, St. Anthony organized supplies for the poor and negotiated release for prisoners of war between Italian city-states. WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Traditions Explained

Question: Why do we celebrate the Hearts of Jesus in the month of June?

Answer: Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is an ancient practice. We can see its Scriptural origins in Jesus' own references to His Heart. "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest...for I am meek and humble of heart" (c.f. Matthew 11:28, 29). The devotion received a surge of popularity in the late 1600s. Jesus appeared several times to a French religious sister, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, pointing to his heart. During this time, the Jansenist heresy had risen in France, which preached limited predestination for salvation. When appearing to Margaret Mary, Jesus affirmed his love for all mankind: "Behold the Heart which has so loved men that it has spared nothing." He asked for a special feast celebrating his Sacred Heart on the Friday following the feast of Corpus Christi. Over time, June has become known as the month of Sacred Heart.
