More Thoughts On
New Year's Resolutions

Last week we gave you a few suggestions to help make stewardship part of your New Year's resolutions. This week, we wanted to give you a few more ideas to build upon those resolutions.

Give More: Good stewards realize that everything they have is entrusted to them as a gift to be shared. There is no better place to begin than sharing with the community that gathers around the Lord's Table at Mass. Consider what you are giving to your parish and local diocese and commit to an even greater contribution as circumstances allow.

Make a Difference in

Your Parish Community: Believe it or not, your parish community can use your talents. Offering your talents to your faith community is one of the most effective ways to feel useful and connected to others, and it is a potentially life-changing New Year's resolution.

Consider Living More Simply: We cannot find fulfillment in possessions. They add nothing to our self-worth. Jesus blessed the "poor in spirit" in his Sermon on the Mount; and Saint Francis of Assisi urged us to live with only what was necessary, for that is how we begin to find God.

Get Healthy: Studies show that most people in North America are accelerating their own decline into premature old age, owing to poor diet and lack of physical activity. Be a good steward of your body. If necessary, plan a complete overhaul of your diet and exercise habits.

Don't Give Up: People give up their New Year's resolutions because of perfectionism and unrealistic expectations. So take it slow, be kind to yourself and keep trying. Resist the urge to throw your hands up and quit. You succeed through small, manageable changes over time.

Turn to the Lord: Ask the Lord for guidance, strength and perseverance in achieving your resolutions. In his letter to the Philippians, Saint Paul writes: "I can do everything through Him who gives me strength" (Phil 4:13). If God is the center of our New Year's resolutions, they have a better chance for success.

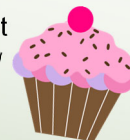

Celebrate Your Marriage - Feb 18

Join us for a prayer service, dinner and dance



Every February, thoughts turn to love with Valentine's Day. And every February, we make an extra effort to remind ourselves of the commitment we made to our partner in Marriage. Marriage is truly a gift from God and sometimes we forget that. Marriage is a sacrament and an integral part of our faith life.

“So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, no human being must separate.” (Mt 19:6) The phrase, quoted during the ceremony of the sacrament of marriage, is taken directly from scripture and places God at the center of the faith union.

In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, there are several sections on marriage and family. When discussing the sacramental nature of marriage, the Catechism notes, “For baptized persons, Jesus raised the human institution of marriage to the dignity of a sacrament in which the love of a husband and wife truly make present the love of Jesus for the Church.”
