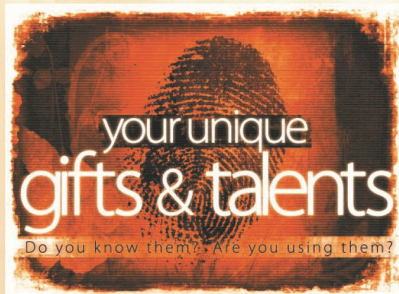


From Our Stewardship Council


In his first letter to us, St. Peter (4:8) writes: *"Put your gifts at the service of one another."*
