



Philip as a model Steward

Philip understood very well Jesus' words: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." We learn of Philip's devotion to prayer, evangelizing and healing in the region of Samaria; made up of communities that would not be very receptive to the followers of Jesus. Philip is a model steward, living his discipleship day by day in the Lord without being obstructed by feelings of what cost his actions might entail.

For his part, Jesus promises, "I will ask the Father and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, because it neither sees him nor knows him." Our God created us, keeps us in existence,



lived like us, died for us, and rose from the dead as our guarantee of eternal life, and is with us always.

As the popular song proclaims, "Our God is an Awesome God. He reigns from heaven above, with wisdom, power and might. Our God is an Awesome God." How can we respond to such an Awesome God? Our response is to acknowledge, accept, develop and use all that God created us to be for own benefit and enjoyment, and for the benefit and enjoyment of others. If we listen carefully, we may be able to hear Jesus shout, "That is awesome!"

Good stewards summon the courage to proclaim the Lord and to serve Him by ministering to others. As an Easter people, eager to rejoice in the Lord, it is important to reflect on how we are living out our own commitment to discipleship.



Why Do We Do That? Catholic Traditions Explained

How do we know when we receive the Holy Spirit? Answer:

My brothers and I discovered something as we got older. There's a little bit of Dad in us. Each time we catch ourselves using one of his gestures, expressions, or comments about a meal, we say, "I'm getting more like Dad!" When we are confirmed, we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit. There is no radical change in us that makes us seem suddenly different. Over a period of time we come to see that there is a little bit of the Spirit in us. We catch ourselves using the gifts, and often end up wondering where a bit of wisdom came from, why we were so patient, or we feel an intensity in our prayer. Perhaps we felt drawn to deepen our spiritual life or found courage in witnessing to our faith. That's when we know we have received the Holy Spirit. We take on his image. Yes, we grow in age, grace, and wisdom, but we also grow in our awareness and understanding of the working of God in our life-we realize we're getting more and more like God. Our thoughts, words, and actions carry that quality and others also see it in us. You might call it holiness. But be confident-there's a little bit of God in all of us!

You will immediately receive a text back with a link to download the app from your smart phone's app store.

After you have downloaded the app, please be sure to turn on notifications for ministries and groups you are involved with to ensure you get messages sent directly to your phone.

Just tap the three horizontal lines in the upper left corner, choose "notifications" and then tap the groups you want to follow for news and information.
