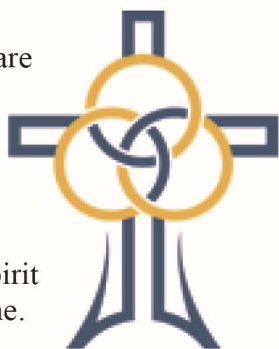
The Holy Trinity

In the Gospel of Matthew 28:19 we hear Jesus instruct his Apostles, “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” This is, of course, one of many references in Holy Scripture to the Holy Trinity which we celebrate on this Solemnity today.

When we receive the Eucharist at Mass, we are receiving more than the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Jesus Christ; we are also receiving the Father and the Holy Spirit because they are all One. This concept of Three Persons in one God is surely a mystery beyond our comprehension. We take this belief on faith as part of our Catholic beliefs because our human brains can never fully understand it.

We received the Holy Spirit when we were confirmed, but we also received the Father and the Son. When we look at the Tabernacle which is in every Catholic Church throughout the world, we know that Christ is present, but the Father and the Holy Spirit are as well. They all dwell in heaven which means that our Tabernacle might be called a “gateway to heaven.”

Do we think of all this when we come into the church, when we attend Mass? We should. The Holy Trinity is present there every hour of every day and every day of every month and every year. That is one of the reasons we need to attend Mass — to understand and celebrate the Holy Trinity.

Why Do We Do That? Catholic Traditions Explained

Question:

Why don't Catholics add the "For yours is the Kingdom..." prayer at the end of the Our Father like Protestants do? Where did it come from?

Answer:

The conclusion of the Lord's Prayer that you refer to is called a doxology, which is a prayer of glory and praise. This particular doxology we do use in the Mass. After the Our Father, the priest prays the prayer that begins, "Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil..." and the people respond with the doxology. The doxology is not found in the Bible, but it is very ancient. It was first found in "The Didache," also called "The Teaching of the Twelve Apostles," which dates probably from about the year AD 90. It was a letter of instruction to early converts to Christianity. Protestantism dates only to the sixteenth century, so the doxology is actually a Catholic prayer. Some scholars and the catechism (#2760) indicate that the doxology was connected to the celebration of the Eucharist and was not used apart from it.

Remember, both the Lord's Prayer and the Eucharist were part of the "mysteries of faith," things taught only to believers. Ironically, a remnant of a prayer used during the celebration of the Eucharist has come to be used widely by many Christian churches that do not celebrate the Eucharist! Truth is indeed stranger than fiction!

Baptismal Font Railing Installation

The second phase to begin soon



You have probably noticed the new railing that now encircles our baptismal font at the entrance to the church. This railing has been “in the works” for quite some time.

The art and environment of the church is a very important part of our overall commitment to making the church and our campus not only beautiful, but also a place of prayer and serenity.



Once we determined a railing around the font was necessary, it was decided the railing should be as beautiful as the font itself. We reached out to an artist who has done other projects for Saint Thomas More and asked for input. The consensus was to celebrate all the sacraments with the copper inserts on the rail. The inserts were fabricated over several months and then recently shipped to a local contractor who installed them within the railing.

The final touch will come with the installation of granite around the font to match the stone already there.

This project is one of several improvement initiatives that are taking shape around the church campus.

Over the next few weeks, we hope to introduce other projects that will enhance the beauty of our already stunning church.
