Holy Mass

Dear brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ,

The Holy Eucharist, Vatican II tells us, is "the source and summit of the Christian life" (Lumen gentium, no. 11; cf. Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1324). Bishop Fulton J. Sheen said, "If you don't get anything out of Mass, it's because you don't bring the right expectations to it." The Mass is not entertainment rather it is worship of the God who made us and saves us. It is an opportunity to praise God and thank Him for all that He has done for us. Let us all know the importance of the Holy Mass.

What are the benefits of Holy Communion?

It strengthens our union with Jesus; He lives within us in a special way. It cleanses us from venial sins. (Mortal sins require forgiveness in Confession.) It gives us grace to avoid sin in the future. It increases our love of God and neighbor.

Why do we have to worship with other people?

God made us social beings. He wants us to come together in community to worship Him. Jesus said, "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I" (Matthew 18:20).

What are the consequences for others if we stop going to Mass?

Our ancestors risked persecution, even death, to be able to take part in Mass. When you have children someday, they will need the graces and strength that come from the Mass. If you fail to pass it on because of your own indifference, you will do the gravest injustice to them and to God. You have the power to snuff out, in one generation, the faith that has sustained your family for generations. This is an enormous responsibility. You will have to answer to God for it.

Mother Teresa said, "The Most Holy Eucharist is the lifeblood of the Church. In it the whole spiritual wealth of the Church is contained. Mother Teresa went to Mass every day and she could be able to do God's mission tremendously. I expect all the registered members of the three parishes participate in the Holy Mass on every Sunday and try to participate on every day without fail. May God bless you.

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by a priest or deacon. Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Bishop William P. Callahan at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. The form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse. Office for Clergy; or on the diocesan website at: www.dioceseoflacrosse.com. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
