The Diocese of Vellore was started by Salesians in 1952 carving out a portion from the Archdiocese of Madras-Mylapore. Further, in 1969, few parishes from the Archdiocese of Pondicherry-Cuddalore were attached to this Diocese. It comprises two civil districts namely Vellore and Tiruvannamalai. There are 95 parishes with 480 mission stations having a Catholic population of 1,78,980. The given below are the defined mission mandate of the Diocese of Vellore, South India.
