

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by a priest or deacon. Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Bishop William P. Callahan at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. The form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse, Office for Clergy; or on the diocesan website at: www.dioceseoflacrosse.com. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception. St Joseph. and St John Cantius!

Today marks one month since my arrival here in your communities! It has been a very blessed month and it truly feels like a home here. I have been so impressed by the true kindness of everyone! Thank you!

Last Sunday I decided to venture out on my bicycle for the first time since arriving here. Within the first five miles I got rained on and then just as I was about to leave Merrillan I got a flat. Apart from the fact that we need rain it was a rather unfortunate ride. But it got me thinking about spiritual things - as so often events like these do.

In our Gospel today we continue with the sixth chapter of St John, a very important chapter regarding Eucharistic theology. Jesus says at the conclusion of the reading this Sunday, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst."

In the moment when my bike got a flat, I didn't know what to do. I have biked several thousand miles in the past and not once have I had a flat. But today it happened. Soon I got my bearings and realized I could just call someone and through the kindness of one of our parishioners I was guickly back home.

Jesus says he is the bread of life. When our life is difficult do we remember to go to Jesus? Do we say a small prayer? Do we visit Jesus in the church? Do we light a candle at a shrine? Do we place our confidence in God who is the bread of life?

Jesus says that if we go to him we will not thirst and we will not hunger. Do we believe him? God answers prayers in unexpected ways. We may not get the answer we anticipated. His answer, however, is always better than we imagined. Trust that Jesus is the bread of life! He always gives the graces we truly need.

There is no better place to encounter God than in the church. It is here that he remains day and night in the Holy Eucharist. In each of our three churches Jesus is truly present. What a blessing to know that he is so close!!

Please pray for me as I continue the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!
