

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by a priest or deacon. Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Bishop William P. Callahan at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. The form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse, Office for Clergy; or on the diocesan website at: www.dioceseoflacrosse.com. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception. St Joseph. and St John Cantius!

It has been a great week of parish activities! It was so wonderful to see so many people at my welcoming dinner in Alma Center last Sunday. Food is a great seque into a brief commentary on our Gospel for this weekend. We continue to read from John chapter six. As you return back home and go about the daily activities create a deep desire within yourself to receive again the most Holy Eucharist at your next Mass.

Jesus says he is the bread of life. He says that when we receive him we shall live forever. Jesus has instituted the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper and instructed his apostles (and the priests who followed them) to do this in memory of him. Thus even in our present age wherever Holy Mass is celebrated we receive the true living bread from heaven.

Please pray for me as I continue the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!
