# From the Pastor's Desk

Today is the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

We are most grateful to the members of our Society of Catholic Women (SCW) for their end of the fiscal year gift of \$6000 to support the work and mission of Saint Hugh Parish. In addition to fundraising, the SCW provides spiritual and social activities for its members and for our parish. Thank you!

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, most commonly referred to as the RCIA, is the means by which an adult - or in some cases a family - prepares to receive the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil.

The rituals are designed specifically for one who is unbaptized (technically a *pagan*) to learn about the church and become part of the Christian community as a *Catechumen*.

Others; including those who were baptized in another Christian denomination and those, who though baptized as Catholic never completed their initiation with Eucharist and Confirmation, may also participate in the RCIA as *Candidates*. Although they will not be (re-)baptized, those who were baptized in another denomination are formally received into the Catholic Church.

Catechumens are baptized and both Catechumens and Candidates receive the sacrament of Confirmation prior to receiving their First Communion - all at the Easter Vigil.

Now is the time to invite those who are interested in learning about the Catholic faith (potential Catechumens and Candidates) to contact the parish regarding the RCIA. The process of discernment has no fixed time frame, but for those wishing to receive sacraments of initiation at the next Easter Vigil (Saturday March 31) this is a good time to be consider the commitment of the RCIA.

Let us continue to pray for one another and for our parish.

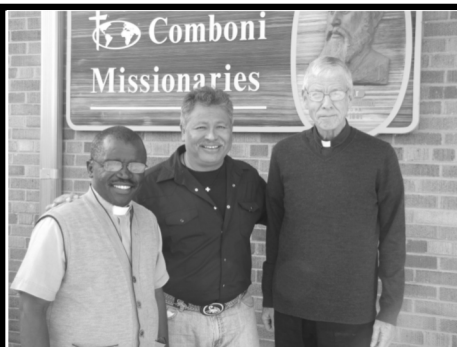

### Praying the Eucharistic prayer by Paul Turner

The eucharistic prayer is the most important part of the mass. It is also the most demanding part. The Second Vatican Council invited the full, conscious, active participation of the people at Mass. During the eucharistic prayer, the priest has almost all the words, but the assembly is not passive. Even here—especially here—in silence and acclamation, we offer full, conscious, active participation.

As the prayer begins, the priest invites us to lift up our hearts. We prepare ourselves to enter into prayer. "[T]he meaning of this Prayer is that the whole congregation of the faithful joins with Christ in confessing the great deeds of God and in the offering of Sacrifice" (*General Instruction of the Roman Missal* 78). The priest prays the eucharistic prayer aloud in the name of the people, but it is essential that all the people pray along. "The people, for their part, should associate themselves with the Priest in faith and in silence, as well as by means of their interventions as prescribed in the course of the Eucharistic Prayer: namely the responses in the Preface dialogue, the *Sanctus* (*Holy, Holy, Holy*), the acclamation after the Consecration, the acclamatory Amen after the concluding doxology, as well as other acclamations approved by the Conference of Bishops with the *recognitio* of the Holy See" (147).

While praying the eucharistic prayer, it may help to think of the following: Give thanks for all that God has done. Ask the Holy Spirit to change the bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ. Remember what Jesus said and did at the Last Supper. Offer to God this holy sacrifice. Ask the Holy Spirit to transform everyone. Pray for the needs of the living and the dead.

## Treasures from our tradition

The premier poet of the English language, Geoffrey Chaucer, introduced one of his most beloved characters, the "Wife of Bath," by this telling remark: "Husbands at church door she had five." Four times widowed, she was setting off on a pilgrimage, notably without number five. The church door is a curious detail, pointing to the fourteenth-century wedding custom of marrying on the porch of the parish church. The goal was to give maximum publicity to the consent of the groom and bride, and so consent was moved from the bride's home to a public venue. The priest would stand in the doorway and begin by sprinkling the couple with holy water. He needed to make sure they weren't too closely related and give them some instruction. He would direct the groom to pay the bride's family a dowry, and then announce the monetary amounts to the interested passersby. Only then would the guests enter the church for the wedding Mass, during which the bride and groom would hold lighted candles. The gradual move from home to church and the shift from the bride's father to the priest's authority helped to protect the freedom of brides who weren't quite as confident as the Wife of Bath.

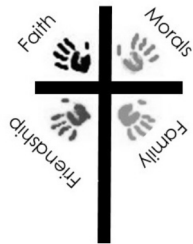
