Mass intentions for St. Jane de Chantal Parish

Our parishioner, Tom Donegan, recently returned from a pilgrimage to Ireland. While there, Tom visited many shrines and sacred places including Our Lady of Knock Marian Shrine in County Mayo. Tom lighted candles all over Ireland for many intentions. I was most touched by his gift to the parish offering two masses said every day for our intentions for one year at the shrine of Our Lady of Knock. With this prayer power I expect some significant spiritual development at our parish through the next year. Thank you Tom for such a generous spiritual gift and trusting in the power of the holy mass graces regardless of where it is celebrated.

Here is the simple story of Knock, a major Marian Shrine. "At about 8 O'clock, on the Thursday evening of the 21st August, 1879, the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph and St. John the evangelist appeared at the south gable of the church at Knock, County Mayo, Ireland. Beside them and a little to their left was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered. There were fifteen official witnesses to the Apparition – young and old – who watched and prayed for two hours in pouring rain. Two Commissions of Enquiry, in 1879 and 1936, accepted their testimony as trustworthy and satisfactory. Today Knock ranks among the world's major Marian Shrines".



Austin Property

A Town Hall meeting was held last Monday regarding the purchase of the property on Austin Ave adjacent north to the rectory otherwise known as the Wengel home. Most gathered if not all were in favor of the purchase and asked some great questions like "what is the decision making process?" Simply said, that process is already in motion gathering much information from many sources including these Town Hall Meetings. I'm in discussion with the Bishop Vicar who supports us if we can pay cash for the property. He's always felt that any property that is adjacent to a parish property should at least be considered if it will enhance the parish proper in some way.

I've been in touch with the Archdiocese Real-estate office and legal department. They help us understand the comparable property in the neighborhood and tell us the limit to bid on a property. In the end I will bring all this info to the Finance Council who will make a recommendation to me. I will take that to the parish staff for a final discussion and decision. I then inform the Bishop and he must sign off on the purchase and begin the legal process with the Archdiocese who legally purchases the property.

I hope this helps to explain the decision making process of such a large purchase. Watch for another Town Hall Meeting to be scheduled for any who couldn't make the last one. Anyone can call my office at any time to share your thoughts.
