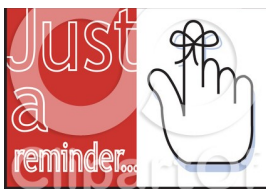
You can send the card to a living father or to the family of a deceased father you are remembering.

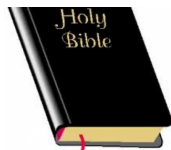

Religious Education and Formation is accepting registrations for the 2015-2016 year. Classes are held on Wednesdays from 6:15 – 7:30. TALKING POINTS

(PRMAA) Priests Retirement Mutual Aid Association is the Administrator of these funds.

Special Collection for Retired Priests of the Archdiocese of Chicago, Sunday June 7, 2015.

This collection is solely for the retired priests of the Archdiocese of Chicago. The retired priests of the Archdiocese receive no funds from the Religious Retirement Collection taken up in December. Those funds go for religious nuns and brothers and religious order priests.

There are currently 202 Retired Archdiocesan Priests. They represent one-quarter of all the priests serving in the Archdiocese. There are currently 100 priests over the age of eighty. Of these 100 priests, 15 are over ninety and one is 104. Collectively our retirees represent over 10,800 years of service to Archdiocese.

Normal retirement age is 70 for Chicago priests, 54 retired priests still live in a rectory and assist the parish on a regular basis. Close to 130 retired priests celebrate Sunday Mass weekly; perform marriages and baptisms; and visit the sick in the hospitals. Without these dedicated men, many parishes would not be able to offer the full range of Masses and sacraments that is currently offered.

There are two independent living residences for retired priests that are subsidized by the Archdiocese. There is space for 28 retired priests to enjoy communal living with their brother priests in retirement, 25 rooms are currently being used. Thirty Five priests received or are currently receiving nursing home assistance or had or have full-time aides coming to their home or rectory in the last year. PRMAA will spend over \$2,300,000 providing this care. Spending has increased in providing home care to keep retired priests in the surroundings where they are most comfortable. The Archdiocese of Chicago is committed to caring for our retired priests but we need your assistance. Please help and many, many thanks.
