

July 5, 2015—Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

FAITH IN JESUS CHRIST

Mark's Gospel account today is built on a double astonishment or amazement: the neighbors and family of Jesus are astonished that he taught in the synagogue with wisdom and worked powerful signs. Jesus, in turn, is amazed that they have no faith in him because they know his origins, not because of any fault with his teaching or ministry. As with many of Mark's passages, we get a rather intimate glimpse here of the human part of Jesus' two-fold nature. To reinforce his point, Mark tells of Jesus' return to his native place, and further points out that he is in the midst of his own family members there. From the very people he expected the most, Jesus received the least. In the day of the Gospel's writing, Mark was attempting to illustrate a lesson to the house of Israel: the God of the covenant expected the greatest faith from the house of Israel, but often received the least. This is a good source for reflection on our part, we who are Jesus' followers today. For the wisdom of Christ to continue and for our lives to be seen as signs of his power, he must expect and be able to find great faith among us. Will he? Can he? Does he? Or is he, once again, amazed by its absence?





EUCHARISTIC MORNING OF REFLECTION

A morning of reflection on the Eucharist is being planned for Saturday, August 1, 2015 for all lay ministers of Holy Communion. We also invite all other ministries to attend for prayer and reflection, including ushers, lectors and sacristans. The program will begin with mass at 8:30 am followed by a light breakfast snack and then the program. We especially will highlight the adoration of the

Eucharist and our handling of it. We will answer any questions or comments in regards to our ministry especially the Eucharistic Ministers. The entire program will be in the church and conclude by 11:30 am.

A special pilgrimage is being planned for the parish on *Sunday, July 19, 2015 (12noon-7pm)* to the National Shrine of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini. This will be

followed by two visits to nearby classic churches. We are still arranging those church visits but wanted to get the word out. Mother Cabrini Shrine is a special place here in the city of Chicago. We claim her as



our Chicago saint. There will be a guided tour of the Shrine and instructions on the life of Mother Cabrini. Depending on the number of participants we will either car pool or get a bus. We will leave immediately after the 11:00 am mass (12 noon) and return after dinner approximately 7:30pm. Sign up by calling the parish office. Sister Maria-Paulina will be coordinating the pilgrimage.

QUESTIONS OF PARISHIONERS

Father, does the most recent decision by the Supreme Court legalizing gay marriage for the country mean that you will have to preside at gay marriages? No. This decision makes all civil marriages legal and giving all civilly married people equal rights. It has nothing to do with any religious ceremonies though some religious groups may preside at gay marriages. In the State of Illinois, we as priests and ministers are given the authority to officiate for the state as the official witness to a marriage but must only preside at marriages that our respective religion/denomination give us permission to do. So, the Catholic Church does not give any priest the right or authority to preside at a gay marriage. Thus, according to both civil and religious law, I am not obligated to preside at any gay marriage.

I believe that this Supreme Court decision had no intention of forcing any religion to do something outside its laws and teaching. This decision strictly affects the civil legal rights of married persons.
