

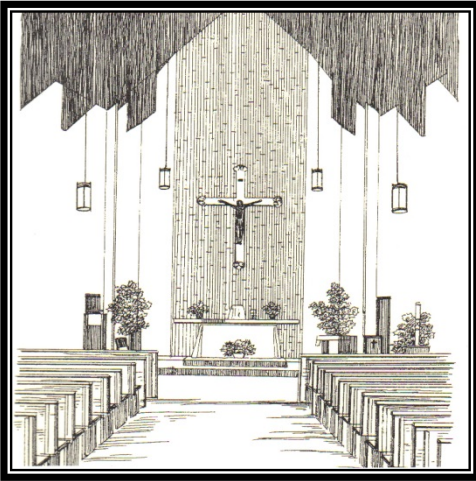

From the Pastor's Desk

This weekend we celebrate Father's Day and it asks us to reflect on our own natural fathers and we can also think about our spiritual fathers. For me, I reflect on my own dad, my brother, and deceased grandfathers. One of the things that all of us are called to living out our baptismal promises is the command that we hear in today's gospel. When we reflect on the reality of the need to take up our cross we may ask the regular questions: how, why, and when?

An important part of what our parish offers is something during the summer called Totus Tuus. This program has been in our diocese for several years and the goal of it is to hand on the faith, in particular parts of the Catechism of the Catholic Church and one set of the mysteries of the Rosary. The name of the program, Totus Tuus, comes from the Latin motto of Pope Saint John Paul II which means Totally Yours. This is taken from a prayer to Mary which comes to us from Saint Louis de Montfort: "I belong entirely to you, and all that I have is yours. I take you for my all. O Mary, give me your heart." We say this with the confidence that Mary always points us to Jesus and this is the goal of the summer program coming up. The program for our junior high and high school students (students going into grades 7-12) will begin on Sunday, July 31st and end on Thursday, August 4th. The grade school (students going into grades 1-6) program will run from Monday, August 1st-Friday August 5th.

Lastly, there is a sign-up sheet for ministries on Sunday, July 3rd. Due to the July 4th holiday, it is difficult to schedule people for different slots without having to re-schedule everyone. Please sign up to help if you are available.

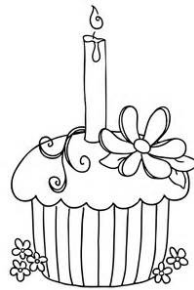

Banana Brownie Bread

2 very ripe bananas
1 box Betty Crocker brownie mix
1/3 cup butter, melted
1 egg

Heat oven to 350°F. Line 8x4- or 9x5-inch loaf pan with cooking parchment paper; spray paper with cooking spray. In medium bowl, mash bananas with fork. Stir in brownie mix, pouch of chocolate syrup (from brownie mix box), melted butter and egg just until moistened. Pour batter into pan. Bake 40 to 50 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 10 minutes; remove loaf from pan to cooling rack. Cool completely, about 2 hours, before slicing.
