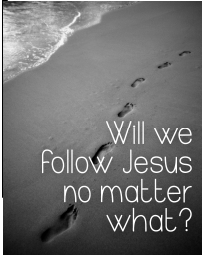

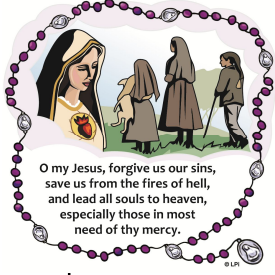

Greetings in Christ! It was a blessing to be with Bishop Swain and (I'm estimating) 5 or 6,000+ others at the Sioux Falls arena last Sunday. One of the thoughts that came to my mind in such a setting of how Christ is truly our King and Lord over all the history of mankind. It was wonderful to be celebrating 125 years as a diocese as a small part of the Church which dates back nearly 2,000 years to the time of Jesus Who established her. It was good to see quite a few from our parishes make it to some of the events over the weekend. Hopefully, some were able to see it on TV or streaming online.

A big thank you to Ethan Lumber Co-op for their work to put up the much needed storage shed on Sacred Heart parish grounds and generous donation of a significant portion of materials and labor. If we are not able to secure any purchasers of the pews soon at former Holy Rosary church in Tripp, we now at least have a place in which to store them. Our insurer (Catholic Mutual) has also been seeking for us to move the stack of tables we have out of the CCD wing hallway, so now we'll have a place for them.

As for the pews, in Ethan, there is interest from another parish of possibly purchasing 30. Offer a prayer that they will want them.

There are several persons interested in purchasing one or two. I plan on calling those persons soon. Hopefully, we'll be able to reduce the number of pews on hand in Ethan to a manageable number that we will be able to place in the various classrooms in Ss Peter and Paul church basements and possibly a couple along the wall in the entryway of the parish hall.

Thanks to the fellows who are working on a "game plan" for the big job of transferring the altar (and other granite items) from Ethan to Dimock (between the church and cemetery). (Again, the hope is just as a temporary setting and to one day find another Catholic church where it can be used daily.)

We are almost to the start of CCD! First classes for both parishes are on Wednesday, Sept. 2nd, 7 to 8:15pm. I'm glad to hear that we did fill the 5th grade class with a teacher. We are still in need of 6th, 7th and 9th grade teachers at Sacred Heart. Are you willing to do half the year? Maybe we can have team teachers for those grades? If not, then the texts are to be sent home with the parents of the students in those grades. 6th and 7th have workbooks to be filled which show that the student read the chapters. 9th graders will have to come in for testing near the end of each semester to see if they read and comprehended their texts and hence be able to advance to 10th grade next year.

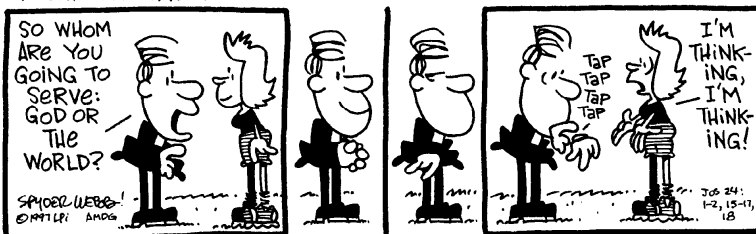

Son: I'm not going back to school tomorrow!

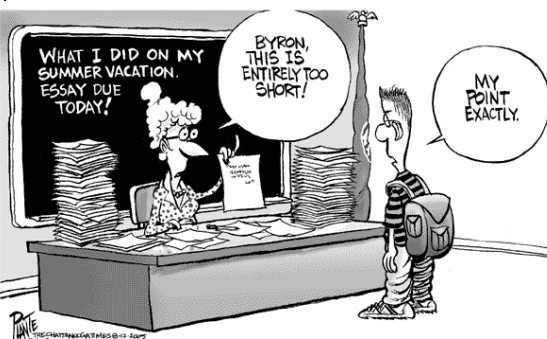
Father: Why not?
