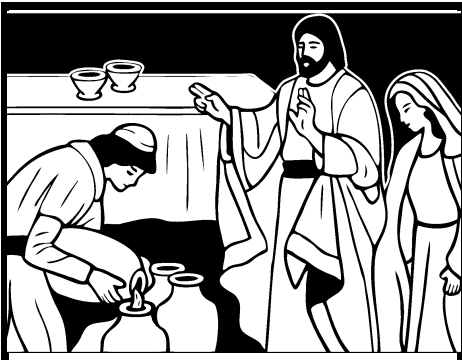

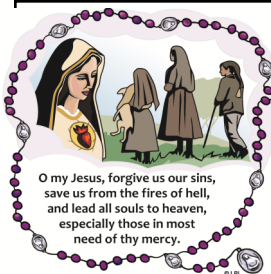

Greetings in Christ! Next weekend we will have our annual seminarian benefit luncheon at Sacred Heart parish (overseen by Catholic Daughters and Knights of Columbus). Maybe some day we'll have some more priestly vocations from our parishes. It has been a while! Confirmation candidates in need of more service hours can help here!

I will be visiting my parents in California from the 19th through the 26th. Fr. Thury will be available for needed priestly ministry help. Please check the bulletin Mass schedule for weekdays as that will be different than typical.

- For those entering grades 9-10 ~ June 13-16, 2016 and for those entering grades 11-12 ~ July 10-13, 2016

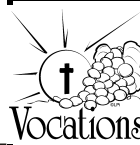
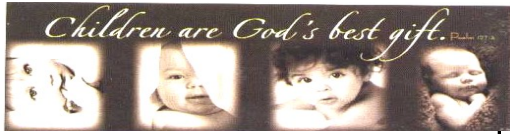
