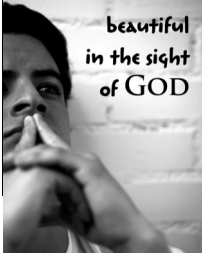

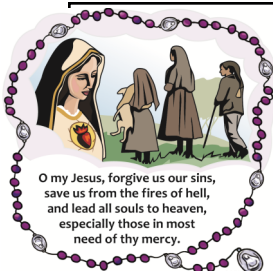

Greetings in Christ! The meetings with CCD teachers and parents of Confirmation candidates went well. Thank you to all who came. We are still in need of some CCD teachers for Sacred Heart parish: 6th, 7th and 9th and 11th grades. Sacred Heart parents of no teacher grades will need to pick up the texts and receive some brief instructions and to instruct their child at home and make sure lessons are read/ discussed and work book completed (for grades 6 & 7 & 9). 11th graders will come in toward the end of the semester on Wed. evening to be tested (date to be announced.)

CCD classes begin this coming Wednesday, Sept. 2nd, 7pm to 8:15pm, both parishes. (Students and teachers should meet in the church first for prayer and then dismissal of each grade to their classroom for the year.)

We have sold some from each location. It would be wonderful if we can sell them all or almost all from their current locations to save us on having to move and store them to another location. Those who purchase pews are responsible for transporting them, but we can get helpers to load them onto vehicles or into trailers.

My most recent doctor appointment revealed that my PSA count has risen and also my cholesterol level. I'll have to see my internal medicine doctor again in three months instead of six. The doctor wanted to put me on a statin drug right away. However, I requested that I go back to taking "slo-niacin" instead. It takes a while to build up tolerance for a full dosage, so if you happen to see me with a red/flushed face, know that it is just a temporary skin reaction after taking the slo-niacin. In three months we'll be able to tell if that helped to lower my cholesterol level as it has in the past.

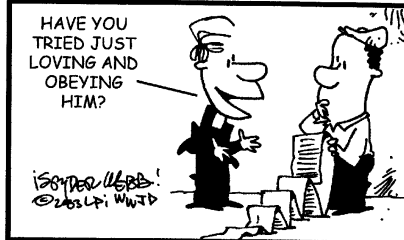
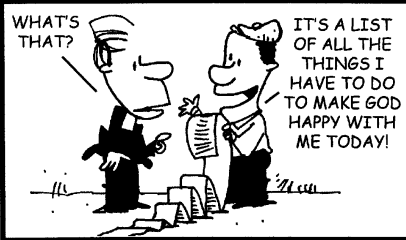
