**Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time,

As I write this, JoAnn and I are in St. Louis, Missouri for a family wedding. On our way back home we are going to witness the solar eclipse and should be in the path of totality. Witnessing one of the unique spectacles of God's creation should be a terrific experience. On Friday, we visited the graves of my in-laws, Robert and Doris Schlesinger. They passed away within four months of each other after being married for over 60 years. At the graves we offered prayers for them and prayers for us. On Saturday we attended a wedding of one of JoAnn's many cousins. All these events have one thing in common. All are blessings from God—natural events that show God's majesty, the celebration of lives lived well, and events that give us hope for the future.

In today's gospel from Matthew we hear of the proclamation from St. Peter declaring that Jesus is the Christ, Son of the Living God. God revealed himself to St. Peter. He continues to reveal himself to us today in nature and relationships.

Too many times, we are given negative news and we dwell on the negativity. There is a saying in broadcast "journalism:" "If it bleeds, it leads." The more sensational a story, the better it is for ratings. But with the negativity comes the stifling of hope and the failure to recognize the good things around us.

Lately in the news we hear of all the divisions that are supposedly keeping us from being the best we can be. Greg Kandra is a Deacon from New York. On his blog he posted a quote from fellow blogger, Letecia Ochoa Adams, who wrote:

*"The hard truth of Catholicism is that even when humans are doing hateful things, they have an innate dignity, because they are created—even the people we cannot stomach—in the Image of*

*God. That inherent dignity must always be respected, and assisted toward its greatest potentiality, even when those humans are neo-Nazis. To fail to do that is to become exactly what the enemy wants.*

*...My Catholic faith, which is rooted in a relationship with the living God, requires me to respect the dignity of all human beings. In simplest terms, it means that, while I get to call out evil behavior for what it is, I do not get to relish the thought of punching these people in the face. I don't get to call them names, or gleefully enjoy it when others do. The only option for me is to recognize the evil acts as evil, fight for justice, and pray for the conversion and redemption of those people carrying Nazi flags, because Christ hung on a cross for them just as much as he did for me.*

*Yes, my only option is the difficult option, because Catholicism is not for the faint of heart. Holiness is not something comfortable or easy; it is other-worldly. 'The world offers you comfort. But you were not made for comfort. You were made for greatness,' said Pope Benedict XVI to a group of German pilgrims. At this moment, my Catholicism is calling me to strive for greatness, and that means choosing the more difficult path, just as my Lord Jesus did."*

I have a challenge. The next time you come to Sacred Heart, look around at the people who are attending Mass. See how many backgrounds and cultures are represented. Watch how people interact. See the smiles. See the people patting each other on the back and laughing and talking. Strive to see God working in the lives of each of us. After that, you may be tempted, as I am, to go home and avoid the news reports of doom and gloom or even to unplug your television and computer!

May we take the love of God from this place to the world!

### SUMMARY

Works under the direction of the Pastor in accordance with the Galveston-Houston Archdiocesan and Sacred Heart Church policies and guidelines. The Bookkeeper at Sacred Heart Church must understand and support the mission and vision which the Pastor has set for the parish. Their behavior must not violate the faith and moral laws of the Church or the Archdiocese such that it can embarrass or give rise to scandal.

### JOB DESCRIPTION

The Sacred Heart Bookkeeper is responsible for performing a variety of bookkeeping duties within the Parish.

**Reports to:** Business Administrator.

**Receive work direction from:** Administrator and Pastor.

**Status and Work Hours:** Part-time, normally not exceeding 24.5 hours per week.

**Provides work direction to:** Volunteers.

### Basic Functions

The bookkeeper is responsible for handling the fundamental aspects of Sacred Heart's financial recordkeeping, including recording financial transactions, logging parishioners' contributions, managing accounts payable and receivable, reconciling bank statements, processing payroll, and completing annual tax forms.

### Specific responsibilities

1. Support the Church's spiritual and pastoral mission.
2. Record and maintain weekly contributions and other cash receipts.
3. Make bank deposits and handle receipts of money.
4. Code and/or verify accounting codes for accounts payable.
5. Reconcile appropriate purchase order and invoice activities and pay vendors for delivered materials.
6. Pay bills and maintain ledgers.
7. Prepare payroll, perform state and federal payroll filings; update payroll system accordingly as needed.
8. Assist with budget preparations.
9. Reconcile diocesan saving accounts and vendor accounts with parish records.
10. Maintain and account for petty cash funds.
11. Maintain accounting records and prepare financial statements, reports, and reconciliations as necessary, including the profit and loss statement and balance sheet. Distribute as needed.
12. Prepare employee census including insurance information; prepare and maintain employment records; enroll employees in benefit programs.
13. Ensure existence of verifiable audit trail for all financial transactions.
14. Maintain required property and other insurance records.
15. Distribute departmental budget reports to pastor, department heads, and finance council chair for monthly review and approval.
16. Oversee the financial aspects of parish and parish-related fundraisers.
17. Arrange for special licensing as required by state or local authorities.

18. Act as VIRTUS coordinator and maintain VIRTUS records, schedule and attend VIRTUS related training classes.
19. Perform other duties as assigned.

1. Associate's degree in accounting or business administration or equivalent business experience, as well as a knowledge of bookkeeping and generally accepted accounting principles.
2. Proficient in computer skills including Microsoft Office products.
3. Working knowledge of accounting software packages.

6. Able to work collaboratively with other staff and volunteers.
7. Able to honor and maintain confidentiality.
8. Able to maintain record keeping systems.

### Be A Rock!

Peter's history as a follower or friend of Jesus is a bit spotty. It might be natural to wonder if Jesus, in giving him the keys to the kingdom, didn't feel a bit like a parent giving a teenager the keys to the family car. But it was at the moment when God's power and presence broke through everything else to raise up Peter's great profession of faith in Christ as Messiah that Jesus chose to establish the bond between the loving, forgiving mercy of heaven and our vocation to be witnesses of that love, mercy, and forgiveness on earth.

Like any parent, Jesus no doubt foresaw the failings, the irresponsible maneuvers or impaired senses, the collisions that the church would be headed for. But, most importantly, he also saw us at that moment as God prefers to see us: capable of manifesting great faith, with a willingness to remain at the feet of Christ to understand what it truly means to be Messiah and Christ. As the letter to the Romans points out to us today, we have not known the mind or the wisdom of God, but God knows us and still chooses to manifest the reign of justice, joy, beauty, and peace through us. Let this be our vocation. Let us always strive to be solid ground on which the church of Jesus Christ can be founded and on which it can continue to be built.

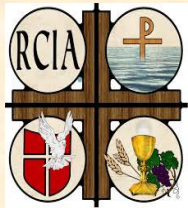


