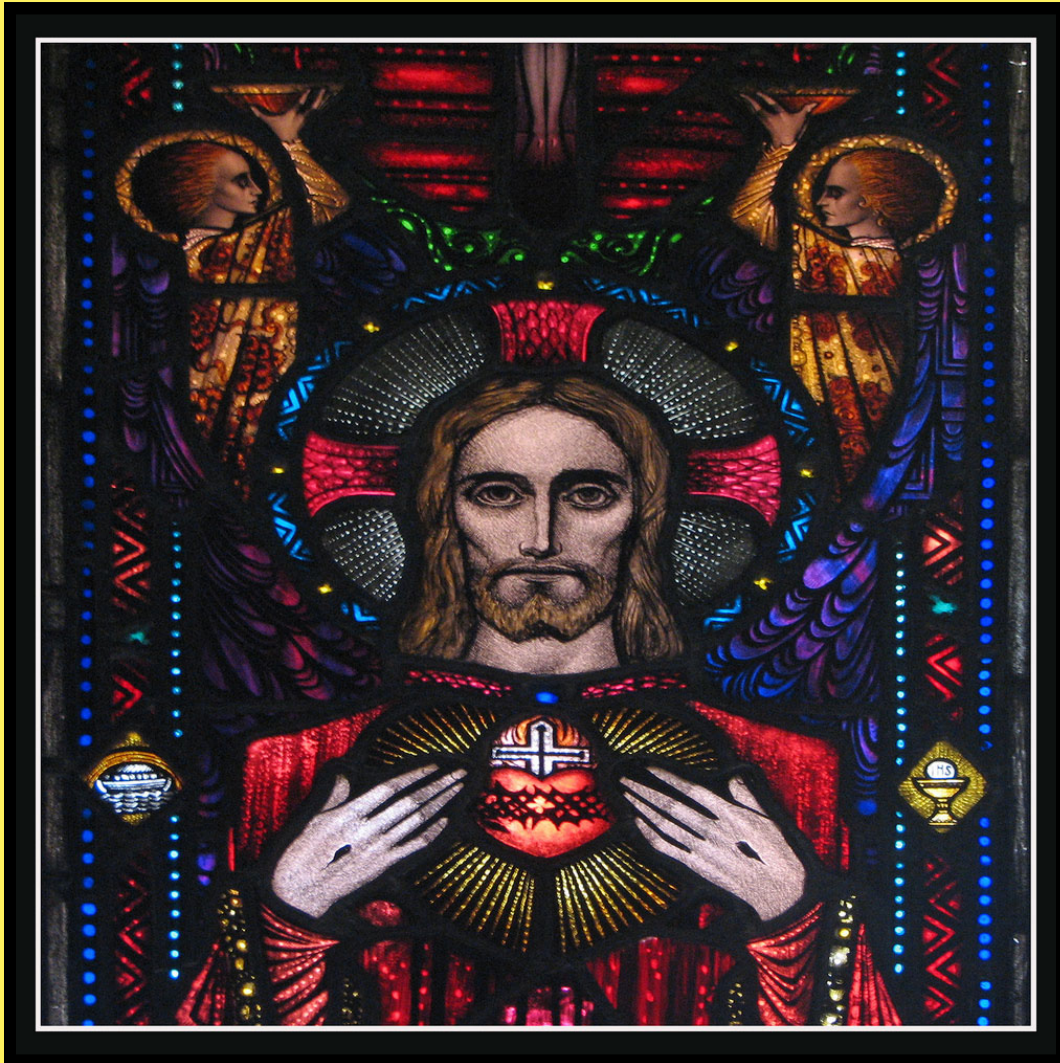

***The Transfiguration of the Lord,
Year A,

LISTEN!

*“Lord, it is good that we are here”
(Matthew 17:1-9).*

Dear brothers and sisters in the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus:

Indeed, it is always good to be in the presence of the Lord! Peter was ecstatic at the sight of his master manifesting His true essence.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord. Let’s make one point clear. It is **not** His “*transformation*.” Jesus did not change into somebody else; rather, He “*transfigured*” or manifested His true essence to all of us.

Notice what our Lord Jesus did. He took Peter, James, and his brother John to the mountain top. Why? So they could be alone with Him in prayer. But why so high? So there would be no distractions. Life under the mountain is hectic; we tend to forget the real important things of life.

Pope Benedict XVI in *Jesus of Nazareth* writes that the Lord took them up the mountain so that he could free them from the burden of everyday life. What does that mean? It means that the Lord wants us to lift our heads, to look up, rather than to keep looking down. Instead of looking down at others, at ourselves, and even at God we must learn to look up at Him.

Have you ever climbed a mountain before? What is the main direction you look? But of course, “up.” Let’s give a moment of thought to that word. What are some of the acts involving the “up” direction? Acts such as *give up, get up, go up, grow up*, and the like are words of transformation. To transform “*worldly men*” into “*Godly men*” we must give up our old carnal self, get up from the ground of self-pitying, grow up from the dirt of fault-finding, go up with the Lord to the mountain top, look up at Jesus, and see God in His true nature. That is what we celebrate today,

—the transfiguration of our Lord. And in so doing, we celebrate our very own transformation.

To witness the transfiguring Lord is to be transformed into a “*Godly person*.” Once you see God in His true nature, you can no longer be the same. You will change. As St. Paul says, “*It is no longer I who live, but rather Christ who lives in me*.” It is similar to a little boy who visits the hospital and sees a doctor wearing a white coat examining his patients. He goes home, cuts the table cloth, and makes a white coat for himself. He wants to be like a doctor. Perhaps one day he will be. The act of witnessing is transforming. The little boy no longer lives his boyish life, but the image of the doctor lives in him.

To see the transfigured Jesus and be transformed demands a simple faith, a faith that comes from a pure heart. A pure heart is a heart full of trust and confidence in God’s word. That pure heart is filled with prayers.

In our pastoral council meeting last month, one member shared a thought which keeps lingering in my mind till now. He shared that when two or three of us gather together to pray with one mind and heart in His Holy Name, Jesus promised that He will be present in our midst. “But,” he added, “when two or three of us gather together to spread gossip in the ‘name of sharing,’ *who* is present among us?” You guess the answer.

The conclusion is simple. As St. Peter’s reaction points out, it is good to be in the presence of God. This divine presence is joyful and it comes from the transfiguration of Christ. Those who witness the transfiguring Jesus will be transformed into Christ. The way to witness Him is to pray. Praying together with one heart in His Name will bring us into God’s presence and purify our hearts to see Him.

Let us pray together for “the renovation” of our own heart, our family, and the whole Church of Sacred Heart.

Eyewitnesses

Today, the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, is a day of eyewitness accounts. The first, a vision reported by the prophet Daniel, was well known to Jesus and his apostles. The vision account was written in quite mystical and figurative language. It is a vision of heaven, powerful and memorable. There are flames of fire, burning wheels, the Ancient One, and a Son of Man. Clearly, Daniel saw something. But was it a dream? Was it real? Was it merely a clever myth?

Peter wants no such confusion about his vision! We are told in Matthew's Gospel what he and his friends James and John saw when they went up on the mountain with Jesus one day. Jesus warned the three witnesses to tell no one until "the Son of Man has been raised from the dead" (Matthew 17:9). Lest readers of one of the Gospels discount the story or simply write it off as a pious myth, Peter gives his own account of the Transfiguration of Jesus in his second letter to the church. He writes with authority, as an eyewitness. He reports this message from God concerning Jesus: "This is my Son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased," and he assures us that the message is "altogether reliable" (2 Peter 1:17, 19).

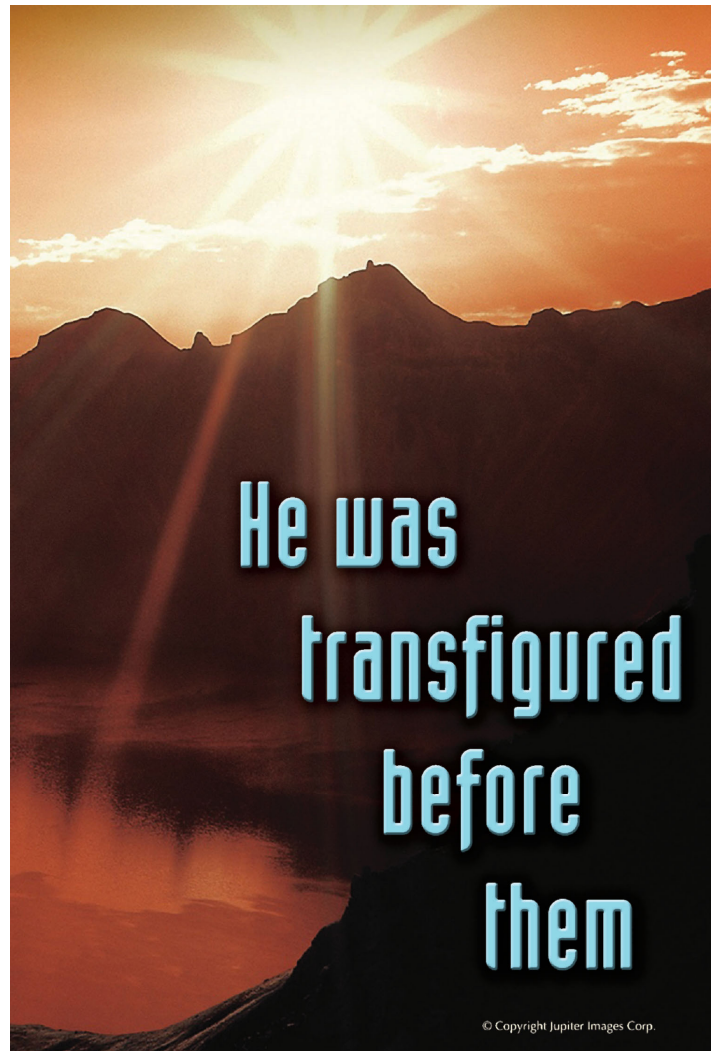

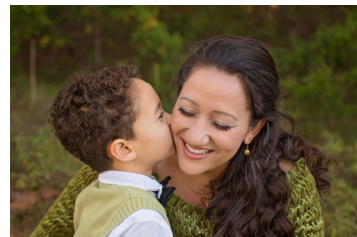
