**Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time,
Year A,
September 10, 2017**

Our liturgy today is directed toward making us aware of the fact that we do have responsibilities toward each other. I think that we are generally aware of our responsibilities as far as the physical needs of others are concerned; but I'm not too sure that we know or remember that we also have responsibilities as far as the spiritual needs of others are concerned.

But more specifically, our readings today are reminding us especially about the responsibility we have to correct the sinner, to be patient with those in error or who do wrong, and to forgive offenses. We must accept the fact that God has appointed us, as individuals and as a community, to be watchmen for each other. The obligation we have to love one another includes the obligation to warn each other about spiritual dangers in our lives, to give brotherly or sisterly spiritual correction. Going along with that is the obligation to be patient and to forgive, and there are roles and times in which everyone has to do these things. It is never easy, and most of us would rather not do it—yet it is a responsibility to be taken seriously, especially by those of us who are parents.

Our gospel selection today was intended to effect reconciliation in the early church community, and the goal of that reconciliation is healing by love so that the community—that is, the Body of Christ—might be built up. As we do this we must remember our own sinfulness and need for correction and forgiveness. We can never allow ourselves to become self-righteous and self-appointed morals officers. And we must remember that the works of mercy are acts of love.

In our second reading today, St. Paul tells us that our motive always has to be one of love. He tells us that we must love our neighbors as ourselves, and that love does not do evil to the neighbor. If we love someone, we desire good for them, and we will speak out even at the risk of straining our relationship. You know, it is easy for us to think of love as doing good things like feeding and clothing and visiting. But the most important aspect of love is to see to another's

eternal welfare, and this can be hard work. "Tough love" is toughest on those who must do it.

St. Paul says that we have a debt to love one another, and if we honestly try to discharge that debt of love we will find everything else falling into place, even the difficulty of giving correction. To love another by being present to them in this way tells them that we are here to see them through their problem; it tells them that we expect goodness from them, no matter what they have done; it tells them that we continue to hope in them; and in doing that, through that love, we gift them with life.

After all, that is what our God did for us. God did not just sit in far-off heaven while we humans went to hell in a hand basket. He came among us in the flesh, hung around with sinners, and chose to die with us and for us rather than abandon us to our sins. That is the love that lies at the root of all mutual correction and mutual forgiveness. It is the very mystery we celebrate in this Eucharist. That is why we gather here for Eucharist. Here we receive from the Lord Jesus his love: a love that is lavish and boundless, caring for others without counting the cost, a kind of love beyond the power of human nature alone. And he lets us share in that powerful love if we join together to ask for it.

As we leave here today we are given the positive duty, the responsibility of being present to one another by growing in love for one another that we might correct and lift up one another, that we might calm those who are frightened, that we might be patient with and forgive those who have done wrong, that we might give mercy without judgment—and that we might welcome corrections of our own faults from others.




