**Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary

“Forgiveness.” This is a powerful word; one that we as a parish community need to practice the most. I would speculate that in any community, the inability to forgive one another is the biggest factor by why people are divided. It doesn’t matter what the cause of hatred is; it could be as mundane as being annoyed at someone’s habits or as serious as someone murdering someone we love. In the end, the inability to forgive is the greatest obstacle in our communities. Unless we learn to forgive, we can never achieve true unity.

Forgiveness is the beginning of healing—not just for our relationships with each other, but for the health of our very own soul. Forgiveness is all about freeing ourselves from the hatred we have of others. It allows love to heal the wounds of our hearts, allowing us to be ourselves once again. If we fail to forgive, then our hatred will be like a cancer which eats up all that is beautiful and good. We become so obsessed with the hatred that it spreads and grows. We cannot recognize beauty anymore; only grief and pain. Before we know it, we will become entrapped in the snares of the devil.

The way in which we can begin to forgive others is to internalize just how much God has forgiven us. This has a two-fold requirement: that we realize the gravity of our own sinfulness, and that we realize how much of a blessing it is to be forgiven by God. The problem of the unforgiving servant in the Gospel parable this week is that he did not internalize his master’s forgiveness. Sure, he was freed from the punishment of his debt, and he was probably glad to have received that mercy. But he did not realize just how grave his sins were, and how grateful he should have been to the master. He did not internalize the fact that he was shown mercy to the highest extent. His debt was unrepayable. He was supposed to lose everything: his house, his freedom, his wife and children. And yet, the entire debt was forgiven. If his fellow servant owed him a much smaller amount, he should have taken into consideration that he was in no position to pass judgment, or to demand punishment.

On the other hand, if the man only knew of the blessings of being forgiven, his soul would have experienced a sense of peace and joy that would not have been shaken by the injustices done to him. After all, forgiveness is a process of healing. To receive forgiveness is to receive an act of love, despite the injuries to the forgiver. To know that we are loved despite causing the other person offense will make us realize what unconditional love is. It will allow us to forgive ourselves, to love ourselves, and, in turn, to love others despite the injuries they caused. If the man would have internalized his master’s forgiveness, he would have realized just how lucky, how blessed he was. Unfortunately, he failed to do so, and so he still allowed negativity to enter his heart.

If we are to forgive others, then, we must first accept the forgiveness that comes from God. We all have three relationships that need healing: God, neighbor, and self. If we accept the forgiveness that comes from God, then our relationship with Him will be healed. But if we are to heal our other two relationships, we need to internalize His forgiveness. We need to realize how grave our sins are, and how much of a blessing it is to be forgiven by Him. By internalizing His forgiveness, we will then have the means to forgive others from the bottom of our hearts. Then, and only then, will we be able to heal the divisions and hatred that we find in our community.

Then the father became seriously ill. The mother called the son and told him he had better come soon. The son walked sheepishly into the hospital room. The father motioned his son to him and whispered: "Did you ever think you could do anything that would keep me from loving you?"

Resentment and anger are foul things, the first reading from Sirach tells us. Remember the last things. Stop hating. Live by the commandments. As Saint Paul writes to the Romans, we are to live for the Lord and die for the Lord.

Jesus' parable in today's Gospel reminds us of God's compassion. The immense sin of humanity has been forgiven and stricken from the record. We are to forgive others in the same way.




