Pastoral Message

5 minutes of the Holy Spirit

Pope John XXIII began a wonderful reform of the Church. Thanks to him, the Church began a great renovation even though he was elected Pope when he was older. However, he said that the author of that work was the Holy Spirit, who wanted to transform his Church. The first nights after being elected, he could not sleep thinking about his tremendous responsibility. Then he asked himself: "Who guides the Church, I or the Holy Spirit?" and he responded, "The Holy Spirit of course." After that he could sleep peacefully.

Let us use his words to invoke the Holy Spirit, and let us do it with the same confidence that he had:

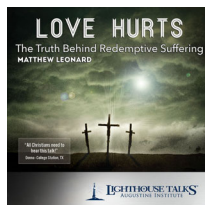

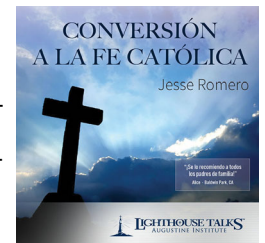

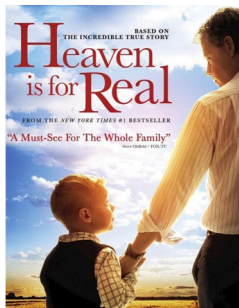

Vocation Corner: The Light of Christ

When I was discerning my vocation in college I would always ask God to show me who I was meant to be. We know Psalm 139:13 says that we were knit in our mother's womb and this knitting was done by the hands of God for a very specific purpose. So, without God we will never know who we truly are. Then how do we do this? Well, God sent His son Jesus Christ to reveal all things to us. So then only when we see the truth of Jesus do we see the truth of ourselves. Think of it this way. When you are driving in your car at night, you have your windshield in front of you and at night your windshield looks so clean, in fact it looks perfect. Then you go to bed, wake up and drive in the morning and all of a sudden in the daytime you can see how dirty the

window actually is. We realize, 'My gosh I need a carwash!' This is because in the darkness you can't see the deficiencies. You are blinded and everything seems okay but when the light shines through then you see the truth of who you are. So, ask God to shine his light on you today to show the truth of yourself and what needs to be cleaned in order to see why He created you, and where do we receive this light most? Mass, confession, and adoration! It is here in these places that we discover Christ and ourselves. So, don't be afraid to go to prayer in the sacraments and adoration. Sit with Christ let His light shine on you and get a Son-tan!
