

Pastoral Message

Brothers and sisters, on this Second Sunday of Easter we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. This celebration is a call to put all our trust in the Risen Lord as it is expressed in the message that appears in the lower part of the picture of Divine Mercy: **“Jesus, I trust in you.”** To trust in Jesus is to listen to Him and believe in Him, to trust in the Risen Lord is to give Him our life, our problems and projects, is to place in Him all our hope; to trust in Jesus is to feel part of his church and be an active part of his church. With the joy of Easter, let us proclaim today “Jesus, I trust in you.”

Message for our parish volunteers

“The community of believers was of one heart and mind, and no one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they had everything in common.” (Acts of the Apostles 4:32)

The first reading from the Acts of the Apostles from this weekend's mass reflects the true spirit of a Christian community, the lifestyle that Jesus wants for his church... **to be all of ‘one heart and one soul’.** A single heart and a single soul expresses the **sense of belonging** to a group and at the same time the **sense of responsibility** towards it. **It is to see that everything that is done must be done for the sake of ‘everything.’** All action, praise, sacrifice, activity, everything must be done for the good of the whole, which is the church.

With this spirit of unity and responsibility I want to remind and invite all our parish volunteers to fill out the forms of the diocesan program called **“Safe Environment.”** It is a task of the church in the United States and the whole world to care and watch over for the protection of every person who celebrates their faith with us. As part of this commitment, training, assistance, and follow-up programs were created for the people who work or are volunteers in the different ministries of the church. This is something very positive and necessary for the sake of “everything.”

Some volunteers have already completed and handed us all the forms (6 forms) that this program requires. Thank you, and God bless you for your generous service. It is necessary to keep in mind that all these forms must be filled out in order for you to keep being part of the different ministries in our church, if there is only one form missing, the system doesn't accept this person. Doing this involves a lot of work and money to perform the background check for each one of our volunteers (we have more than 300 volunteers). But it is something necessary for the good of all. If you are missing any of these forms or if in the process of collecting the forms, they were misplaced, I apologize. During the next couple of weekends, we will have tables in the Gathering Space with a list of the people and the form(s) missing and we will also have copies so you can sign and complete the needed forms. In May I have to send all this information to the Diocese. I know this is voluntary service, but we must fulfill this requirement to exercise our ministries. All priest, religious, staff and volunteers have to follow the same rules.

In the first Christian community ‘all had one heart and one soul’ that is, they had a great sense of belonging and responsibility. **All for the sake of ‘everything.’**

Mensaje Pastoral

Hermanos, en este Segundo Domingo de Pascua celebramos la fiesta de la Divina Misericordia. Esta fiesta es un llamado a poner toda nuestra confianza en el Señor Resucitado, como lo expresa el mensaje que aparece en la parte inferior del cuadro de la Divina Misericordia **“Yo, confío en Ti”**. Confiar en Jesús es escucharlo y creer en Él; confiar en el Señor Resucitado es entregarle a Él nuestra vida, nuestros problemas y proyectos, poner en Él toda nuestra esperanza; confiar en Jesús, es sentirnos parte de su iglesia y ser parte activa en su iglesia. Con la alegría de la Pascua, proclamemos hoy, “Señor, Yo confío en Ti.”

Mensaje para los voluntarios de la parroquia.

“La multitud de los que habían creído tenían un solo corazón y una sola alma; todo lo poseían en común y nadie consideraba suyo nada de lo que tenía.” (Hechos de los Apóstoles 4,32.)

La primera lectura para la misa de este fin de semana, de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, refleja el verdadero espíritu de comunidad cristiana, el estilo de vida que Jesús quiere para su iglesia... **ser todos un ‘solo corazón y una sola alma’.** Un solo corazón y una sola alma, expresa el **sentido de pertenencia** a un grupo y a la vez el **sentido de responsabilidad** frente a él. **Es ver que todo lo que se haga se debe hacer por el bien del “todo”.** Toda acción, alabanza, sacrificio, actividad, todo debe mirar al bien del todo, que es la iglesia.

Con este espíritu de unidad y responsabilidad, quiero recordar e invitar a todos los voluntarios de la parroquia a llenar las formas del programa diocesano **“Ambiente seguro para nuestra comunidad.”** Es una tarea de la iglesia de USA y el mundo entero cuidar y velar por la protección de toda persona que celebra su fe con nosotros. Como parte de este compromiso se han creado programas de formación, asistencia y seguimiento a las personas que trabajan o son voluntarios en los diferentes ministerios de la iglesia. Esto es algo muy positivo y necesario por el bien del ‘todo’.

Algunos voluntarios ya han completado y entregado todas las formas (6 formas) que este programa implica. Gracias y Dios los bendiga por su servicio generoso. Es necesario tener presente que se deben llenar todas estas formas para poder seguir siendo parte de los diferentes ministerios de nuestra iglesia; si falta una sola forma por llenar esto hace que el sistema no acepte a esta persona.

Hacer esto implica bastante trabajo y dinero para el ‘background check’ (revisión de antecedentes penales) de cada voluntario (Tenemos más de 300 voluntarios). Pero es algo necesario para el bien de todos. Si te falta alguna de estas formas o si de pronto en el proceso de recolectar las formas se perdió alguna de ellas, por favor mis disculpas. Durante estos fines de semana tendremos mesas en el área de socialización de la iglesia, con copias para ser firmadas. En el mes de mayo tengo que enviar toda esta información a la Diócesis. Yo sé que es un servicio voluntario, pero tenemos que cumplir con este requisito para ejercer nuestros ministerios, todos los sacerdotes, religiosas, personal y todos los voluntarios.

En la primera comunidad cristiana ‘todos tenían un solo corazón y una sola alma,’ es decir tenían un gran sentido de pertenencia y de responsabilidad. **Todo por el bien del ‘todo’.**




