

Pastoral Message

During this Easter season I would like to thank each one of you for being part of the St. Rita community and for your unconditional support. Last week I mentioned in the homily that faith for the first Christian community meant a strong sense of belonging and a sense of responsibility with the community. When you feel part of a group, of a community, you know that there are commitments involved.

One of our responsibilities in this community is the Stewardship goal. We have until the end of this month to reach our goal and fulfill our diocesan commitment. The purpose of this collection is to reach those who didn't make a written commitment. We invite these people to support our parish in this task. Of course, if all of these people would make a commitment at the beginning of the campaign, during the first week in May, and they would fulfill their commitment, we wouldn't have to do these collections.

Each year we have had to use the parish's scarce resources to pay the debt generated by the parishioners' lack of support towards the Stewardship. This causes a big problem. During the summer we have a sharp decrease in mass attendance, which means a drastic reduction in the regular collection during mass (the only source of income to pay our bills and sustain our parish.) Using our money to pay for the stewardship debt means we don't have money to pay bills and services during summer, which is a big headache!

We belong to this diocese and the sense of belonging implies a commitment to it. Thank you all for your cooperation.

Mensaje Pastoral



En este ambiente de la Pascua, quiero agradecer a cada uno de ustedes por ser parte de esta comunidad de Santa Rita de Cascia y por su apoyo incondicional. La semana pasada en la homilía mencionaba que la fe de la primera comunidad Cristiana en Jesús significaba para ellos un gran sentido de pertenencia y a la vez un sentido de responsabilidad frente a ella. Cuando te sientes parte de un grupo, de una comunidad, también sabes que hay compromisos frente a ella.

Una de nuestras responsabilidades en esta comunidad es la meta del Stewardship o de la corresponsabilidad. A finales de este mes se cumple el plazo para alcanzar la meta y cumplir con nuestro compromiso diocesano. El propósito de esta colecta es llegar a aquellas personas que no hicieron un compromiso escrito. Invitamos a estas personas a apoyar a la parroquia en este sentido. Por supuesto si todas estas personas hicieran su compromiso al iniciar la campaña, en la primera semana de mayo, y lo cumplieran no tendríamos que recurrir a estas cosas.

Cada año hemos tenido que usar los pocos recursos que tenemos en la parroquia para cancelar la deuda que se genera, con el no apoyo de todos los miembros de la comunidad, al Stewardship. Esto causa un gran problema. Durante el tiempo de verano la asistencia a las misas disminuye dramáticamente, lo cual significa una gran reducción de la colecta regular de cada misa (única entrada que tenemos para pagar todos los recibos y sostener la parroquia). ¡Usar nuestro dinero para pagar la deuda del Stewardship es no tener dinero para pagar recibos y servicios de la parroquia en el verano, lo cual es un gran dolor de cabeza!!!

Nosotros pertenecemos a esta Diócesis y este sentido de pertenencia implica un compromiso frente a ella. Muchas gracias a todos por su colaboración.







Vocation Corner: Jesus Knows the Next Step

It amazes me that just about every time Jesus appeared to His followers after His Resurrection they did not recognize Him. Even after spending so much time learning from Him and following Him, they still could not tell who He was when He came to them. I believe that at least part of the explanation for this is that they were becoming too focused on themselves after the death of Jesus. After He died, we can certainly imagine that they must have been very scared and unsure about how to move forward in their lives. It was at this point that they put it upon themselves to find the next right step, rather than placing their trust in the plan of Jesus. In fact, they did this so to such an extent that even when Jesus Himself appeared to them, they could not recognize that it was Him and that He had everything in control. It is easy to fall into



the same trap in our own lives, especially when it comes to discerning a vocation. Trying to find your vocation can be a difficult and stressful thing at times. However, the last thing we ever want to do is take the matter into our own hands and feel like we have to be the ones to figure everything out. Jesus already has the plan! All we have to do is trust in Him. Rather than getting too turned in on ourselves, we need to surrender everything, especially our whole future, to Jesus and simply be calm while He makes Himself known to us. We do not want to miss the Will of Jesus in our lives. Be calm, trust in Him, and always be open to recognizing Him no matter what circumstances you are facing in your life.
