Pastoral Message

Friends,

Since the season of weddings is just beginning, I want to offer you a little reflection about Job and his wife. Job is described in the bible, as a man who stands out for his righteousness and his respect for God. In that book of Job, it is also mentioned how he is well known because of his wealth. He had "seven sons and three daughters, many servants, owned seven thousand sheep, three thousand camels, five hundred yokes of oxen, and five hundred donkeys." (Job 1:2-3)

Job's story tells us how God allowed Satan to attack him, first in his position, losing sons and daughters, servants and animals. Then, his body was wounded with incurable sores from the feet to the head. (Job 2:7) After all of that, Job never cursed God. His story is the story of a just man's suffering; a man who loves God, and although he does not understand the reason for his sufferings, nevertheless accepts them, confident that there will be a better future.

My attention is especially drawn to verse 9 of chapter 2, in the same book. "His wife said to him, 'Do you still persevere in your faith? Curse God and die!'" It is neither the invitation to curse God, nor the questioning of faith that attracts my attention, but instead, the fact that his wife, up to this moment in history, is still present and at the side of Job. Job has lost sons, daughters, possessions, and even his health, but not his wife. We could make many conjectures, or conclude with the not so appropriate joke that "the devil didn't want Job's wife", but I think there is a deeper truth. There are some ideas that can help us better understand this part of history.

First, we must say that Job's wife is not a "possession" of his. She is a person; free, independent, with dignity --- not a *something*, but *someone*. She is his partner, not to be "owned", therefore, she was not attacked when Satan attacked Job's possessions. This first approach continues to leave the possibility that in the second attempt in which Satan attacked Job, she would have been attacked since as spouses, the two are one. She was not attacked, and despite not being Job's best counselor, during all the time of suffering, she was always with him.

Perhaps the answer is in the nuptial blessing that is given to the spouses on the day of their wedding: "...God, you who have wanted the union of man and woman and have blessed this community; established from the beginning, with the only blessing that was not abolished neither by the pain of original sin, nor by the punishment of the flood...". The union of man and woman narrated in the book of Genesis, in which each one is a help and inseparable company to the other, is protected by God throughout the history of salvation. The book of Job is not the exception. Marriage is also respected in this passage of scripture.

Certainly, there have always been imperfections in marriages, and the story of Job addresses this point. That is why it is necessary to constantly look to God's plan for marriage, and thus purify our intentions, heal our past wounds, and learn to be a better spouse every day.

Mensaje Pastoral

Amigos y amigas,



Ya que la temporada de bodas está comenzando quiero ofrecerles una pequeña reflexión acerca de Job y su esposa.

Job es descrito en la biblia como un hombre que destaca por su rectitud, y su respeto a Dios. También destaca por su riqueza, el mismo libro de Job nos dice que él tenía "siete hijos y tres hijas. Tenía muchos servidores y poseía siete mil ovejas, tres mil camellos, quinientas yuntas de bueyes y quinientas burras" (Job 1, 2-3). Su historia nos narra cómo Dios permitió que satanás lo atacara primero en sus posiciones perdiendo hijos e hijas, servidores y animales; y después en su cuerpo al ser 'herido con llagas incurables desde los pies hasta la cabeza' (Job 2:7). Y con todo eso Job nunca maldijo a Dios. Su historia es la historia del sufrimiento del justo, que ama a Dios, y aunque no entiende el porqué de sus sufrimientos, sin embargo, los acepta confiado en que habrá un futuro mejor.

Llama particularmente mi atención el verso 9 del capítulo 2 del mismo libro: "su esposa le dijo: «¿Todavía perseveras en tu fe? ¡Maldice a Dios y muérete!»" No es la invitación a maldecir a Dios, ni el cuestionamiento de la fe lo que llama mi atención, sino el hecho que la esposa, hasta este momento de la historia, sigue presente y junto a Job.

Job ha perdido hijos, hijas, posesiones, e incluso su salud, pero no a su esposa. Pudíramos hacer muchas conjeturas, o concluir con algún chiste de mal gusto por ejemplo decir que "ni el diablo quiso a la esposa", pero creo que hay una verdad más profunda, hay algunas ideas que nos pueden ayudar a comprender mejor esta parte de la historia.

En primer lugar, debemos decir que la esposa de Job no es una posesión de él. Ella es una persona, libre, independiente, con dignidad, no es algo sino alguien. Es compañera de él, él no su dueño, por tanto, ella no fue atacada cuando satanás atacó las posesiones de Job. Este primer acercamiento sigue dejando la posibilidad de que en el segundo intento en que satanás atacó a Job, ella hubiera sido atacada ya que los dos como esposos son uno solo. Ella no fue atacada, y a pesar de no ser la mejor consejera de Job, durante todo el tiempo sufrimiento siempre estuvo con él.

Quizá la respuesta está en la bendición nupcial que se da a los esposos el día de la boda: "... Dios nuestro, tú que has querido la unión del hombre y la mujer y has bendecido esta comunidad, establecida desde el principio, con la única bendición que no fue abolida ni por la pena del pecado original, ni por el castigo del diluvio..." La unión del hombre y la mujer narrada en el libro del Genesis, en la que 'cada uno es ayuda y compañía inseparable del otro' es protegida por Dios a lo largo de la historia de la salvación. El libro de Job no es la excepción. El matrimonio es respetado también en este pasaje de la escritura.

Ciertamente siempre ha habido imperfecciones en los matrimonios la misma historia de Job atestigua, por eso es necesario mirar constantemente al plan Dios para el matrimonio y así purificar nuestras intenciones, sanar nuestras heridas pasadas, y aprender a ser un mejor esposo (a) cada día.







Vocation Corner: "Don't stop being yourself"

When I think back to the time just before I entered the seminary, I remember that lots of people were giving me advice. Much of it was good and helpful, but there is only one piece of advice that I received at that time that I still remember today. One of our seminarians gave me this simple encouragement: "Don't stop being yourself". Even though this might seem insignificant, it would be hard for me to overstate how important this piece of advice was for me as I started my journey into the seminary. At that point, I was nervous that I did not have what it would take to be a good seminarian. I was not sure if I was smart enough, holy enough, or well-formed enough to fit in at a seminary and make it through the training process. However, that simple bit of advice that I received from a fellow seminarian reminded me of God's plan for me. God had called *me* to be a priest. He hadn't called me acting like someone else to be a priest; He called *me*. In our Gospel this weekend, Jesus tells us that He is the vine and we are the



branches. He also tells us that He wants to prune us so that we can bear more fruit. It is so important for all of us to realize in our lives that Jesus has called every one of us to a certain mission. He has given us specific gifts, graces, and talents that we need to fulfill the special role that He has for us. He does not need us to act like someone we are not, but He does want to make us the best version of ourselves. This is why it is so important for us to continue to go to Jesus to allow Him to prune us and prepare us for our missions. It is necessary that we go to Him constantly in prayer and the sacraments so that He can continue to purify and sanctify us in order that we might bear much fruit. My advice to you, then, is to simply be yourself. Never be afraid to let Jesus in to prune you and shape you so that you will be the person He is calling you to be and so that you will be able to fulfill the mission that He has for *you*.
