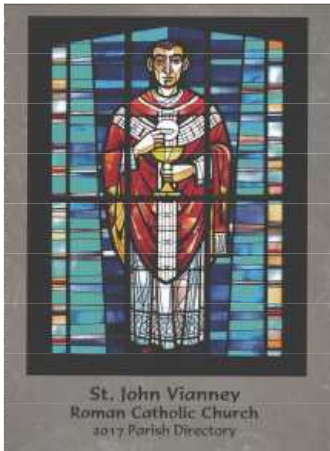
Spread Mercy!

Adult Catholic Spirit Club

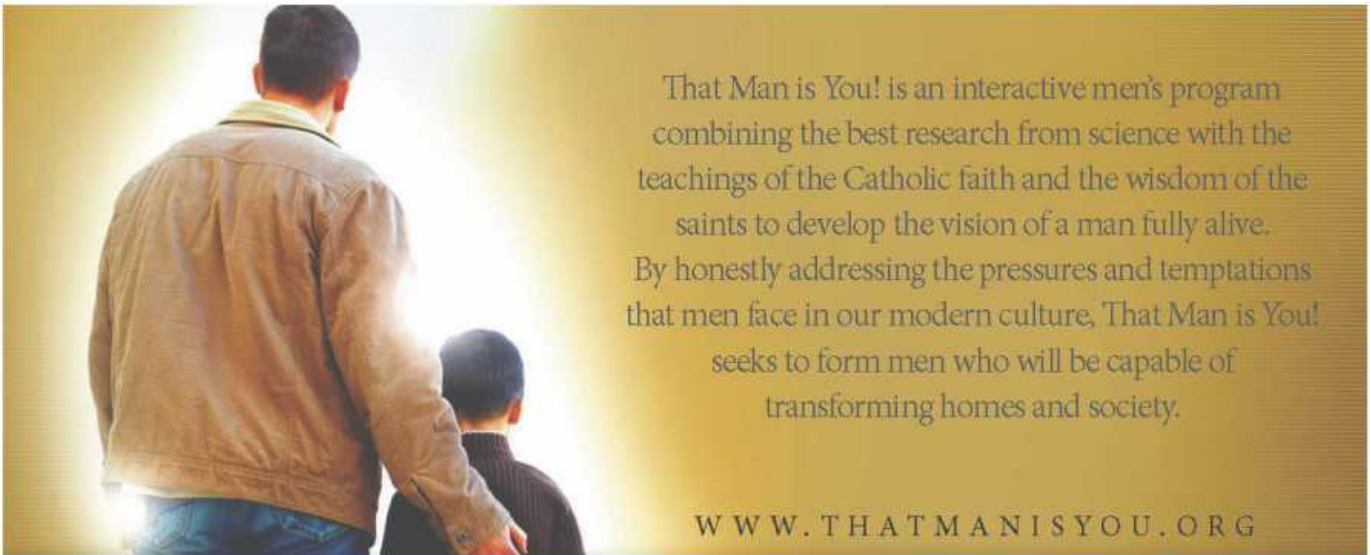
