

- Students who attend Catholic High Schools are now required to attend both Discipleship Prep I and Prep II prior to the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation.
- Preparation to receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Penance is a two-year program beginning with students **entering grade 1 in September of 2015** and planning to receive the sacraments **during the spring of 2017**.
