

FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY



Next Sunday, April 23, is the Feast of Divine Mercy. Following the 12:30 p.m. Mass the Most Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration. A Holy Hour will begin at 2:00 p.m. consisting of the recitation of the sorrowful mysteries of the Holy Rosary with meditations taken from the Diary of St. Faustina and various prayers in honor of our Merciful Savior. At 3:00 p.m. the Hour of Mercy will be celebrated at which time the Divine Mercy Chaplet will be sung and the glorious mysteries of the Holy Rosary prayed. A Eucharistic Procession and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament and veneration of the First-Class relic of St. Faustina will conclude the devotions for the day. **Please note that Vespers will not be sung this Sunday!**

SECOND COLLECTION TODAY

The second collection on Easter Sunday will be the special "My Easter Gift to my Parish" collection. DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

From 1931 to 1938 Our Lord revealed the secrets of His great mercy to St. Faustina. He designated the first Sunday after Easter as the Feast of the Divine Mercy. In preparation for this Feast, He asked that a Novena of Chaplets be started on Good Friday. Jesus said: "By this novena, I will grant every possible grace to souls." (Diary, #796). "I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fountain of My mercy, that they may draw therefrom strength and refreshment and whatever grace they need in the hardships of life, and especially at the hour of death. On each day you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls, and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy, and I will bring all these souls into the house of My Father..." (Diary, # 1209) The intentions for the Novena as dictated by Jesus are as follows:

- 1st day - All mankind, especially all sinners
- 2nd day - Priests and Religious
- 3rd day - All devout and faithful souls
- 4th day - Pagans and those who do not know Jesus
- 5th day - Heretics and schismatics
- 6th day - Meek and humble souls and the souls of little children
- 7th day - Souls who especially venerate and glorify God's mercy
- 8th day - Souls in Purgatory
- 9th day - Souls who have become lukewarm

The Novena will be prayed here at Holy Innocents publicly with veneration of the First Class relic of St. Faustina as follows:

Easter Sunday, April 16 - 10:15 a.m. (prior to the Solemn High Mass)

Easter week, Monday through Friday: 5:40 p.m.

Easter Saturday, April 22 - Following the 1:00 p.m. Latin Mass

If you are not able to pray the novena publicly, please take a novena leaflet and pray it at home on your own.

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world! Jesus, I trust in Thee!
