

Fr. Bob's Blotting's

On this feast, we celebrate Jesus ascending into heavenly glory! For many years, I have always thought of the Jesus' Ascension as a time when he went away from us and left us alone. Isn't that what is depicted in the book of Acts? A closer look after a conversation with some brother priests left me and, I hope, you with a different view.

Jesus leaves us his last words in the Gospel: "I am with you always." This is always a consoling *idea* but often lacks the conviction of *experiencing* his presence, a yearning that is deep in each of our hearts. Since Jesus always tells us the truth, lets take a closer look at the experience of the apostles on that Ascension, 40 days after His Resurrection:

The angels say: "men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky?" Are they doubting still? Are they in awe? They are not frightened of the angels. When Jesus is with you, no thing will frighten you. The Lord is with them!

In the Gospel of Luke, it is more apparent: "he blessed them... and was taken up to heaven. They did him homage and then returned to Jerusalem with great joy." The Christian cannot have joy without the presence of Jesus and His Holy Spirit! Joy is a different way of living. Even in suffering, one can live in joy.

When Jesus passes out of the disciple's sight, he moves from a purely physical way of being to both a full spiritual and physical way of being. Now he is able to appear in his glorified body to certain people (like the Divine Mercy) and be with the disciples in a new way so that they return with great joy.

The angels are saying to these disciples: you have a new way of being, guys! Don't just stand there, get moving! And if we could weave these two accounts together, they then act and go with great joy. They are no longer holding on to Jesus as a merely physical body, but 'they are living in him and he in them and they in the Father,' to adapt John 14:20: "I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you" May we each live this new way of being!
