Fr. Bob's Blotting's

The temptation, since we can't comprehend the mystery Holy Trinity in itself, is to say nothing at all. But, hey, that's never stopped me -just ask my brothers!

For those that heard the homily, you'll remember that it is the experience of the love of the Holy Trinity that matters most in the Christian's life, not the doctrine behind it. Yet, the doctrine provides our sure foundation for understanding our experience of the Love of the three divine persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

One description that Sr. Elizabeth McDonough taught us was that the interaction, interrelationship of the three divine persons - the *perichoresis* - is like a dance of three persons. They move so fast and they are constantly giving and exchanging, that the casual observer cannot tell whom is holding on to who's hand. This is a very good description, yet it has its limits - it does not tell us of the abundance of God, who is love (1 Jn 4:16).

The Holy Trinity is constantly drawing us into their dance of love. We will never exhaust their love for us, for God is goodness itself and only wants to give himself away; the more he gives himself away, the more he has! Indeed, there is only one who decided not to give himself away and he fell from light, Lucifer, along with his companions.

You and I are constantly being drawn into the love of God. Take a moment today to review your experience of the love of God and the presence of the Holy Trinity.

- When did I taste calmness in my life?
- When was I touched by beauty?
- When did truth resonate deeply to me?
- what was a saving act that I received?
- Where have I see the savings acts of God in my community?
- When have I felt loved for being me? By others, by God directly?
- What part of creation - green grass, sunsets, strong winds - have told me of God's providence?

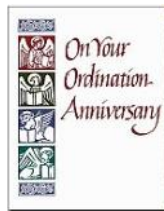
