St. Vincent de Paul Clothing Bin

The clothing bin located between the school and the annex is for the collection of new and good used, but, still usable, clothing. If for some reason you are unable to put your donations in small plastic bags and place them inside the bin, it would be better if you took them to either Planet Aid or Goodwill, both of which are located on Baltimore National Pike.
