Our goal is to provide an opportunity for people of the local communities to remain in their villages to earn an income and improve their lives.

Our objective is to fill an entire shipping a container of food to send to Peru, right after Easter. The Baltimore & Anne Arundel communities have already shown their generosity last year when we collected 38,000 lbs. We're not looking to match it; we aim to double this amount!
