# Operation Mato Grosso

Dear Saint Gabriel' parishioners,

We, Operation Mato Grosso volunteers, extend our sincere thanks to you all who have supported our very successful 2018 Food Drive.

We collected over 70,000 pounds of food, school supplies, books, and over \$7,000 in monetary donations in just two months. We also met our goal of doubling our efforts from last year. Thanks to you and to the support of the other seven Catholic churches and four schools. A special thanks to all the teenagers who spent their Saturdays in front of supermarkets collecting food. We had a total of 48 teenagers come to help.

We cannot find the way to thank you enough for all your support. I still can't believe it. We will load an entire shipping container (40 feet long) in the next two weeks. It will arrive in the port of Lima, Peru by mid-June. The food will be used in our programs – in our schools, parishes' soup kitchens, hospitals, clinics, orphanages, and more.

This container is a sign of goodness of many people; it is more than just food. It carries with it a message of good faith in humanity. In our mission sides, we try to provide a future to young people teaching them to be good and help others as they have been helped. In the U.S., this is an opportunity for teenagers to give their time for others, at the same time building a community among them, a true friendship.

Our youth group is growing, and we hope we will impact more and more young people, both here and in South America.


