#### Food Pantry

All donations of non-perishable food items, personal hygiene items, paper and cleaning supplies, and pet food are always gratefully accepted. #### **ATTENTION**

St. Gabriel needs volunteers to help manage facility rentals during scheduled events. Rental of the Parish Hall, Community Center, and Annex are excellent ways to raise money for the church and church functions. As key holders, volunteers are expected to:

- 1. Unlock rented facilities 15-20min before set up time and turn off alarms.
- 2. Survey rented space to determine if facilities are clean kept up to standards
- 3. Manage events workers to ensure health and safety and mitigate damage of property.
- 4. Collect donations for additional rented items such as table and chairs.
- Maintain time schedule of event to ensure that facility cleaned, vacated and locked.


