St. Gabriel Church has developed a program that we would like to offer our parishioners. The program gives our parishioners the ability to make their regular donations to our church by allowing automatic deductions from parishioner's personal checking or savings account. This program benefits both the Church and the parishioners in the following ways:

How does it work?

To start, you must authorize St. Gabriel Church to debit your checking/savings account monthly, by completing the enrollment form at the bottom of this letter. On the 15th day of each month, your donation is automatically deducted from your bank account. This automatic debit will be recorded on your bank statement just like a check or withdraw. If the 15th day of the month falls on a weekend or a holiday, the donation will be deducted from your account on the following business day.

If you want to discontinue this option, simply send written notice to the Pastor, St. Gabriel Church.

How do I enroll?

Just complete the enrollment form at the bottom of this letter and attach a voided check or deposit slip from your account. Mail or drop off the enrollment form at the Parish Office
