1) You may wish to add a <u>not-so-recent</u> deceased member of your family or friend in the All Souls Day Remembrance celebration with a donation of <u>\$3.00</u> for the memorial candle. Please stop by the office or send your check and name of the person or persons you wish to add by mail or in the collection basket in an envelope labeled: "CANDLES"

The deceased name or names will not be called off during the Masses, but their names will appear on the candle, which will be already placed in the baptismal area. ***Please note, not all candles will be lit at every Mass, due to fire safety we can't have more 25 candles lit at one time***

2) You may wish to leave with us a photo of your deceased loved one to place on our "All Souls Altar"—a custom of the Hispanic communities, especially the Mexicans. Please bring a picture (have your name and phone attached to the back so when it is time to take it back we can remind you to pick it up) and leave it in a box provided and we will add it to our altar (If you wish the name of the person to be display, please add a label to the picture).
